

Keep the winter winds at bay by weatherstripping doors

You will be able to keep out the winter winds and save money with well-insulated doorways. Weatherstripping doors is an easy two-step project that will ensure your doors are winter-proof. Let us talk about how you can be a master at this task.

Weatherstripping your door is simple. It is also relatively inexpensive. You need to seal the sides and top of your door. To do so, you may use foam-edged wooden strips that can be purchased at a hardware store or home center. When you get the strips home, you will have to cut them into lengths to fit the doorway. Cut a section first that is equal to the length of the stop molding, the narrow piece across the top of the doorframe that stops the door. Place the strip on a flat surface and barely drive the nails through it. Go outside, close the door and put the strip into place on the underside of the molding so that the foam touches the door. Press lightly and drive the nails firmly, but not all the way. Test the door to see if it closes easily and the weatherstripping is pressed against the entire length of the door. If it does, drive the nails the rest of the way and add more at four-inch intervals.

Next measure the vertical lengths of the stop molding and cut sections to fit those measurements. The top must touch the underside of the already installed weatherstripping and the bottom must touch the threshold. Install the stripping as before, with nails barely through the stripping until you are sure about the seal on both sides and the top of the door. To hide the stripping, fill the holes with putty. Then sand and paint or stain the door.

You can also try tubing or V-stripping. These kinds of weatherstripping are attached to the doorframe instead of the stop molding and cannot be seen. Cut the strips to fit across the doorframe at the top and down the sides. Cut the side strips into segments leaving the hinges and the door strike areas exposed. The strips should be fastened so that their unattached edges are flat against the stop molding. Attach the strips with nails or, in the case of an adhesive backing, with the adhesive side against the doorframe. Pull the unattached edge outward, away from the doorframe, to ensure the seal is tight.

If you're not satisfied with tubing or V-stripping, you can try spring stripping which attaches to the door frame and the door. However, it is trickier to install than some of the other kinds of weatherstripping. You may have to remove and trim the door to make sure the stripping fits properly.

In any case, adding weatherstripping to a doorway for the first time or just maintaining a door that has been previously treated will keep you warmer and more comfortable. So when the winter winds blow, you will have a sense of security knowing you're ready for them.
