




# Happenings at Georgetown Christian School

At committee-of-the-whole meetings held on the first Wednesday of each month, questions will be answered at the beginning of the agenda. They too must be submitted in writing, but can relate to any aspect of the board's operation.

All questions will be answered on a first-come, first-served basis.

"Trustees are looking forward to the change because, under the old format, the public could wait as late as 11 p.m. to ask a question, or the board wouldn't have completed its agenda and therefore wouldn't get to the public

question period at all," says Halton Hills Trustee and board chair Ethel Gardiner. "By designating a specific time for public question period at both board and committee meetings, we will better serve the community."


