

401 Corridor plan a 'phenomenal win-win situation'

But the 401 Corridor still needs to be serviced. Under a special Halton Region program, Halton Urban Structure Plan (HUSP), pipes have been constructed from Lake Ontario to provide servicing to 6,200 new homes in Milton in Phase 1. At the same time the water pipe was extended across Hwy. 401 to the newly-built water tower, west of James Snow Parkway.

Phase 1A now involves extending these pipes into the industrial lands to near the Sixth Line area.

The total cost is estimated at \$7.3 million with developers committing to pay \$3.9 million. Servicing will only happen if developers agree to "front-end" these costs. Four (Panacea, Great Lands, Legend Motors and St. Lawrence) have already agreed to it in principle. Others who apply for subdivision agreements or building permits will be required to share the cost on a pro-rata basis.

The Town of Halton Hills and Halton Region, however, must pay for the oversizing costs totalling about \$3.6 million — the town's share is \$875,000 (25 per cent) and the region's will be a maximum of \$2.8 million. This money will be recovered through development charges once the servicing is extended from Sixth Line to Winston Churchill Blvd.

Halton Hills council agreed unanimously to proposal at Monday's council meeting.

Mayor Kathy Gastle said it's important the town contribute its share now.

"We do have developers at the table. And to make this go forward we need the developers. They are there and they're willing to write the cheques.

"It is definitely win-win. It's an absolute phenomenal happening for us in Halton Hills," she said.

Halton Region's administration and finance committee also unanimously approved the funding formula at its meeting last week, and the full regional council approved it yesterday (Wednesday).

The town will use the 2001 and 2002 interest from the debt that Halton Hills Hydro Inc. is paying the municipality. Halton Region's financing will come from reserves.

With approval of the funding, Regional Councillor Rick Bonnette said the town has planted the seed within the industrial/commercial community that "Halton Hills is open for business."
