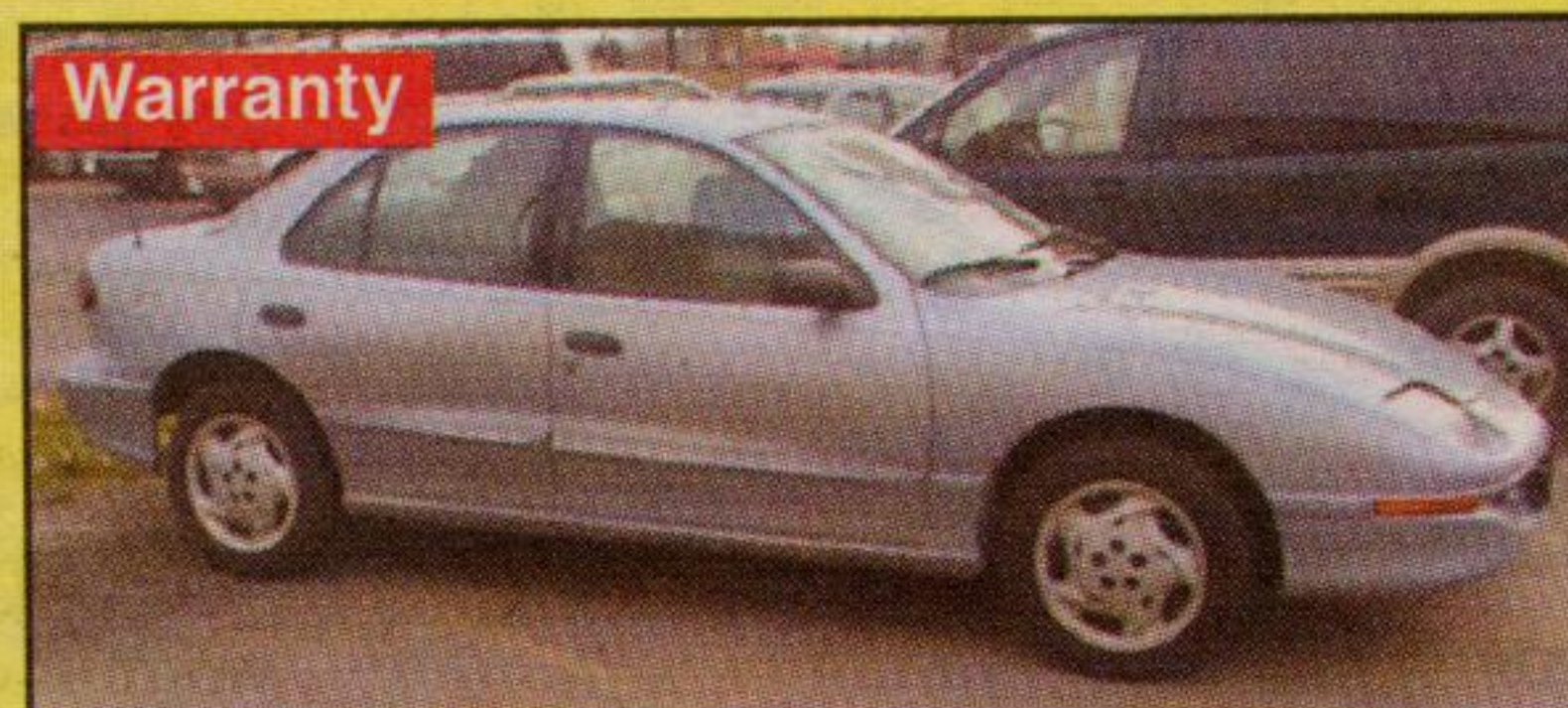

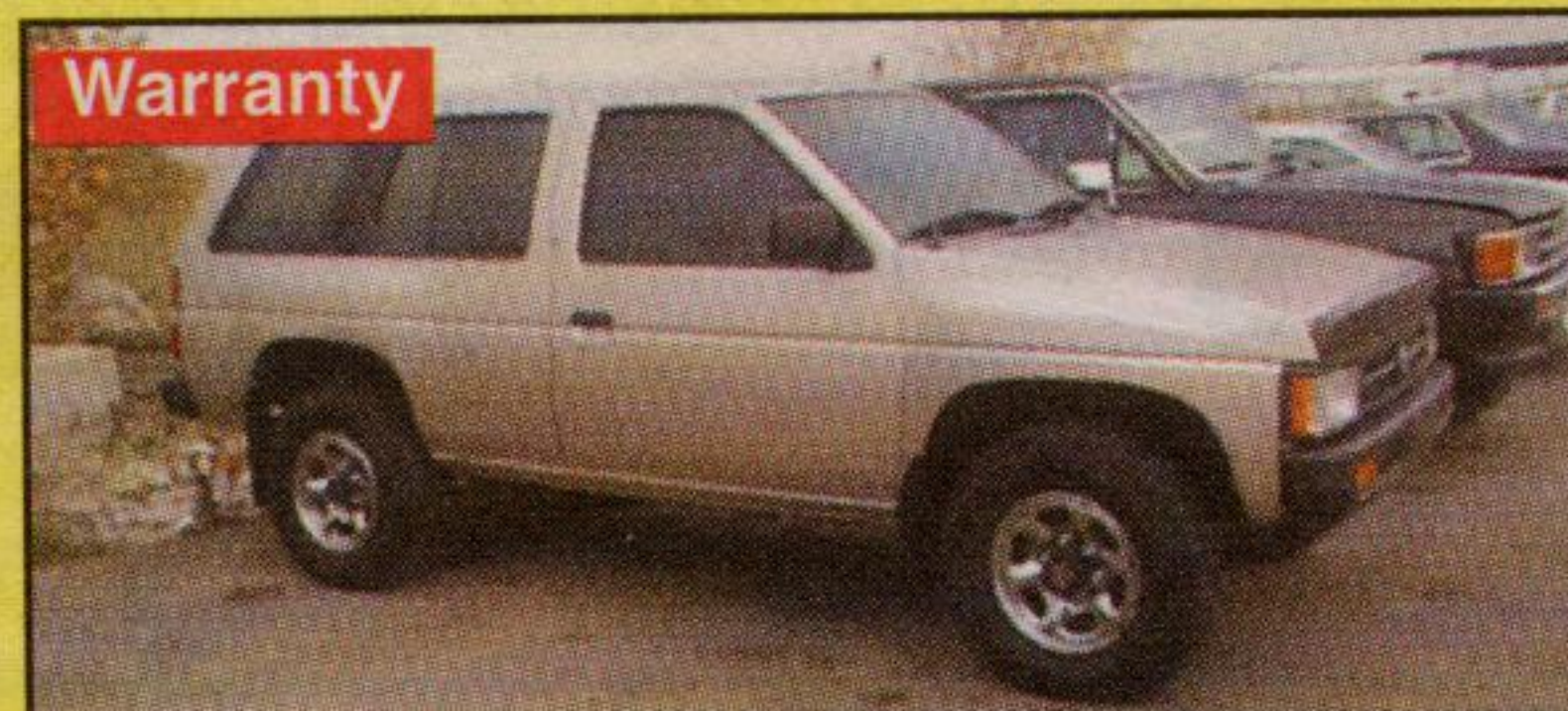

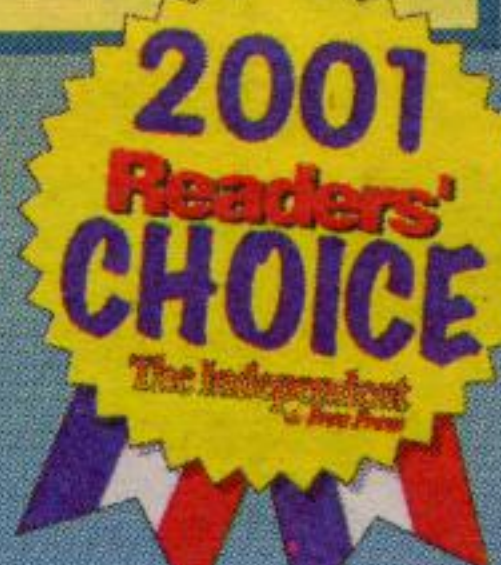

Developments on hold

Ontario Municipal Board pre-hearing on PNA Holdings and Troisville Phase 3 was adjourned last week until the region finds water for future growth in Georgetown.

The hearing won't be rescheduled until there is a reasonable expectation that more water would be available in three years.

The PNA Holdings application is for a 56-unit condominium located beside the Royal Ascot Condominium on Hall Rd. and Georgetown Estates developer John Spina's Troisville Phase 3 application is for 45 homes adjacent to PNA's with access from Fagan Dr.

There is the possibility that Spina could purchase the PNA property to have access for his development off of Hall Rd. however, Gabe Charles, a planner with the town, said at this time it appears he isn't doing that and is looking into other options.
