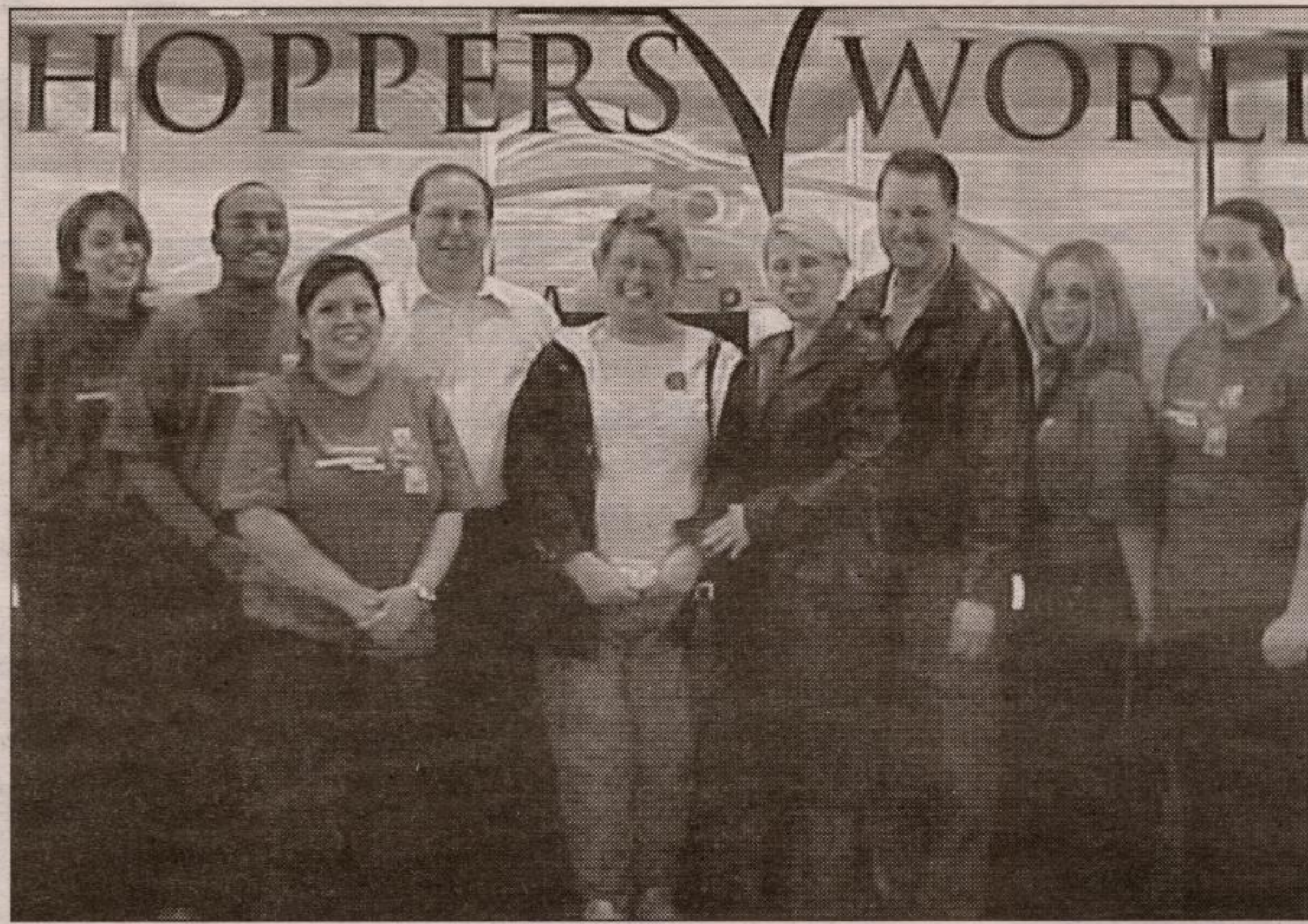


Contest win was in the bag
