GLT's rehearsal hall nears completion

our months after the offidial groundbreaking cere-I mony was held, the new rehearsal hall for Georgetown Little Theatre (GLT) is approaching completion.

GLT members were invited to a special sneak preview recently, and were delighted with what they saw. The original building was destroyed by fire four years ago.

"Our members were unanimous in their enthusiasm over the new building," said Colin Hoare, GLT president. "While we will always have fond memories of our temporary rehearsal space on Armstrong Avenue, our true home has been in Stewarttown, and we are glad to be back. Of course, we will not be able to occupy it officially until we have received the signed Occupancy Certificate, but we are confident that, thanks to the care

and effort shown by all involved in the construction, we should be able to acquire the approval fairly quickly."

Albert Otten and his company Heritage Construction is working on the project.

GLT is still actively raising funds for the new building. Donations can be made through Canada Trust, Building Account #532944. The theatre group has also had the support of the Georgetown Rug Hooking Guild, whose members are presently preparing a banner. Once completed, it will hang in the John Elliott Theatre, and will bear the names of all the 40+ donors.

Georgetown Little Theatre is a not-for-profit group that presents a minimum of three plays a year for more than 40 years.


The rehearsal hall will not be


used as a theatre, Hoare stressed. All productions will continue to be performed at the John Elliott Theatre.


