Novice Hurricanes earn OMHA bronze

The teams were the same and so was the result. The only thing different was the colour of medal the Halton Major Novice Hurricanes were competing

Brandon Denham scored with 2:26 to play to give the Hurricanes a 4-3 victory over the York-Simcoe Express in the bronze medal game of the Ontario Minor Hockey Association (OMHA) Novice AAA tournament in Brampton. The two teams squared off in last year's minor novice gold medal game with the Hurricanes emerging victorious.

"I think that (experience) might have helped when it came to the bronze medal game," said Hurricane manager Mike Massey.

The Hurricanes entered the final period trailing 3-2 after York-Simcoe had scored goals 35 seconds apart late in the second to take the lead. Ryan Brazeau's second goal of the game then pulled the Hurricanes even in third to set up an exciting finish.

Michael Sgarbossa had a goal and two assists for the Hurricanes. Denham also had two assists in the final.

The Hurricanes finished the round-robin


with a won-lost record of 1-3 but advanced to the bronze medal game on the strength of their 3-2 victory over Stoney Creek, who were also 1-3.

The Hurricanes were edged 2-1 by Niagara Falls in their opening game but came back to beat Stoney Creek Friday afternoon. York-Simcoe doubled Halton 4-2 on Saturday and Whitby defeated the Hurricanes 7-2 in their final round-robin game. Whitby defeated Niagara Falls for the gold medal.

Denham led the 'Canes with three goals and three assists in the tournament and Sagarbossa had a goal and four assists. Denham, Ian McCrae and Brazeau had two goals and Christopher Taylor and Nolan Banasco also scored. Stephen Silas had three assists and Daniel Marshall had two.




