FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR LANDLORDS IN ONTARIO

Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC), the federal housing agency, is providing an opportunity for Landlords under the Residential Rehabilitation Assistance Program (RRAP).

Limited funds are available in 2002 to provide landlords with financial assistance to repair or rehabilitate a rental or roominghouse property to a minimum level of health and safety or to convert non-residential properties into affordable rental or roominghouse accommodations.

Landlords wishing to participate must submit their applications by 4:30 p.m. Eastern Daylight Time, May 31, 2002. Applications received after this time will not be considered.


