




Festival ends



Anything Goes opens tomorrow

nything Goes, the first of the great Cole Porter stage musicals, opens L tomorrow (May 2) at the John Elliott Theatre in Georgetown.

Set on board an ocean liner in the 1930s, it has lavish song and dance numbers in the Porter style. When Anything Goes opened in New York in 1934 it was an immediate hit. There have been countless revivals and two movies made of this show. It was the first musical Globe put on in 1982 to mark the new John Elliott Theatre. Twenty years (and over 40 musicals later), Globe is bringing this high-spirited musical back to Georgetown audiences.

Reston Williams (who was the award-winning lead in the Globe's Crazy For You) is back in the lead role as Billy Crocker. Billy's romantic impulse forces him to sneak onto the ship to be near his true love, Hope Harcourt (Karen Mathiasen), who is off to England to marry a stuffy English lord (Warren Harris).

Billy gets mixed up with a gangster disguised as a clergyman (Bill Cook) and his moll (Bobby Flatt) and the usual comic complications ensue.

Add to the mix an evangelist-turned nightclub singer (Elizabeth Bell) and her four "fallen angels" (Sandy Chen, Karen Evans, Diana Rimac and Pamela Scott) and you have a great show.

The director is theatre veteran Brigida Callaghan, music is under the direction of Marilyn Willis and the choreographer is Gord Murray.

The show runs May 2-4 and May 8-11, with a 2 p.m. matinee on Sunday, May 5.




