great brassy Reno Sweeney. Equally strong is Karen Mathiasen, who plays the demure Hope Harcourt, and Warren Harris is quite enjoyable as the stuffy British gentleman, Sir Evelyn Oakleigh.

Bill Cook is very funny as the tough guy Moonface Martin, but has a tendency to overact a bit. His sidekick Bonnie is well played by Bobbie Flatt, and they complement each other as they bumble through their misadventures.

Hope's mother Mrs. Harcourt is effectively portrayed as a snooty society matron by Marg Templeton, while Paul Bell gives us a stiff version of Elisha J. Whitney, Billy Crocker's boss.

The production has some rough spots. Opening night saw numerous lighting and sound miscues, and occasionally the orchestra overpowered the vocalists.

Choreography also had its

moments when it was a bit out of sync, and the lighting changes were too sudden.

The problems will no doubt correct themselves in future performances as the crew become more comfortable with their cues, and the cast will certainly smooth out their wrinkles at the same time.

The material is great, and most of the production features strong vocals, with the familiar lyrics and

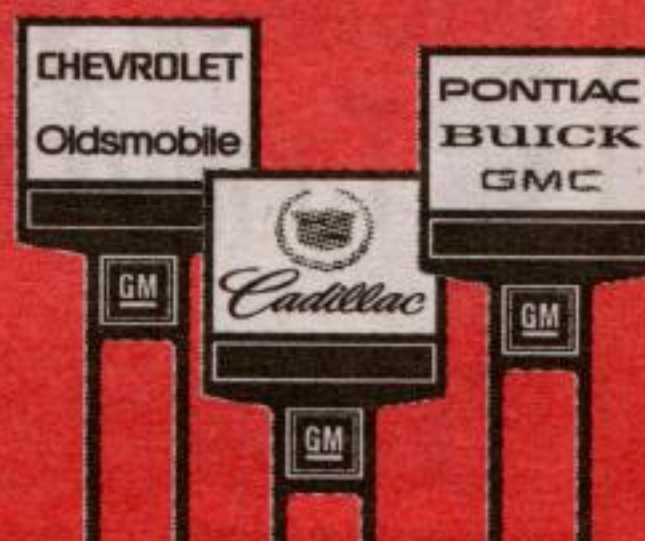
