

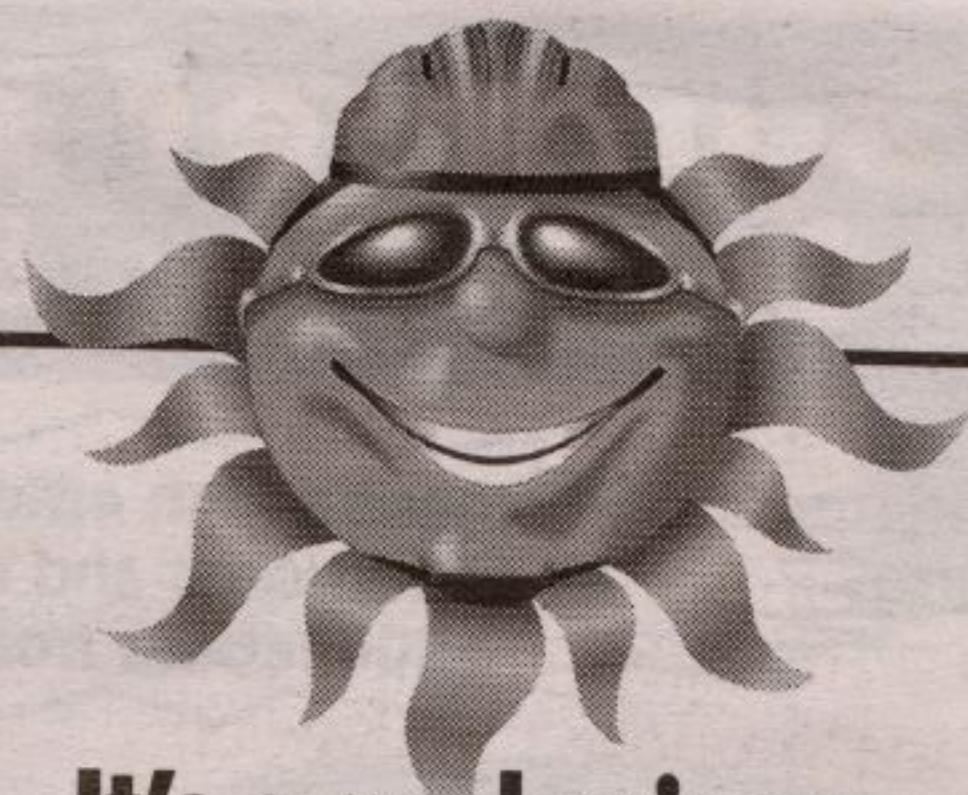

The group, which is developing the Old Seed House Garden as a legacy to the Dominion Seed House business, has a tree donation program and Sarah Burrows, a member of the group, said a tree in honour of mom for Mother's Day, dad for Father's Day, graduations, retirements or other occasions are all great ideas.

She said about half of the 40 trees to be planted in the first phase of the project have already been donated, but there are still approximately 20 available.

Burrows said area residents have donated trees so far for various reasons such as, the birth of a grandson, celebration of longtime friendship between a group of friends, in memory of those killed in the events of September 11, an 80th birthday and in memory of a loved one who has died. The Duke of

Kent also donated a tree during his visit to Georgetown last year, and the Friends group donated a tree to celebrate the new friendship they made while working on the garden project.

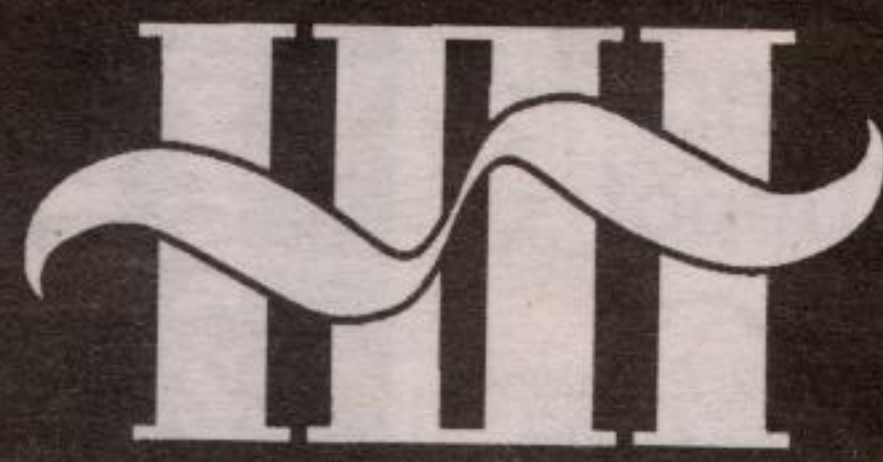
Trees available to be donated include blue ash, Bradford pear, Shubert chokecherry, European mountain ash, ivory silk tree lilac, white fir, dawn redwood, Serbian spruce, Colorado blue spruce, and white pine.

They range in price from \$200-300 which covers the tree and installation. It does not include a plaque which, if desired, will be an extra cost.

Friends of the Old Seed House Garden are also in the process of putting together a program to allow individuals or groups to donate benches, garbage receptacles, bicycle racks, a flag pole and flag, light standards, etc.

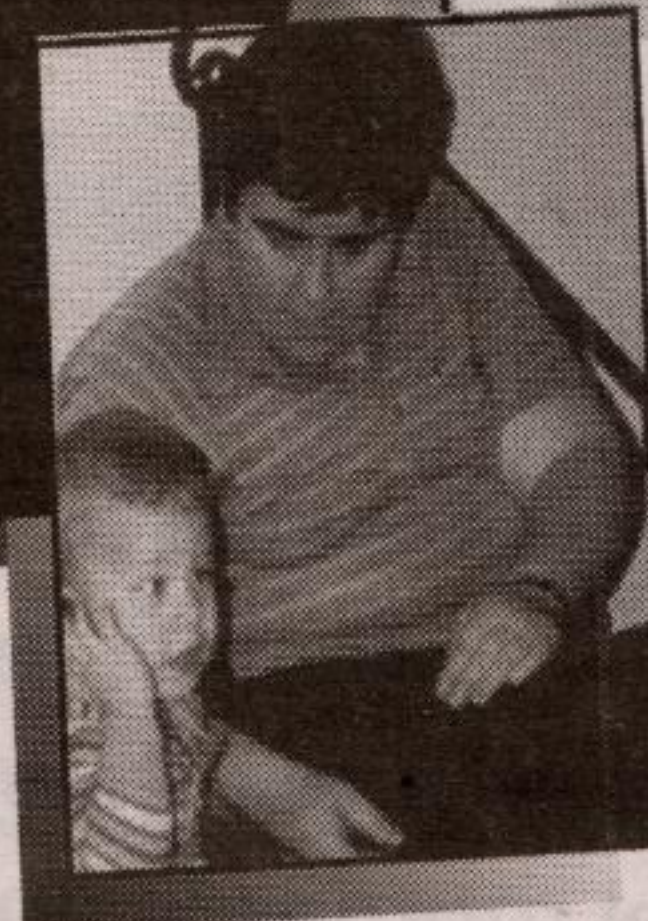
