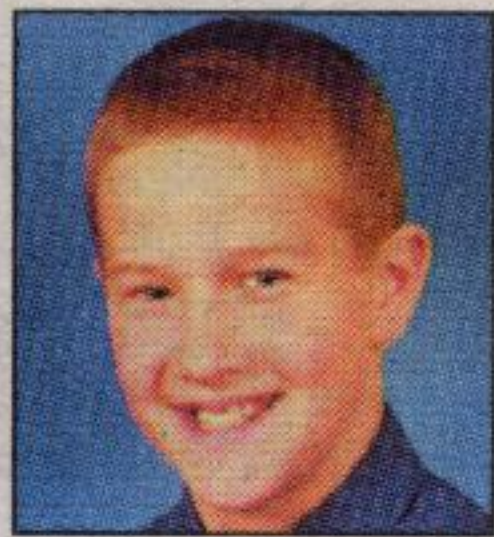

Tara Bishop

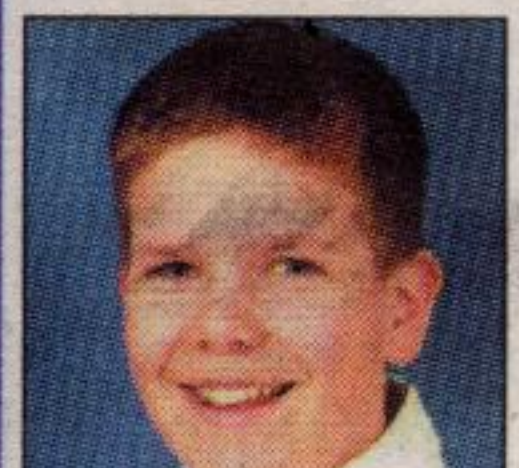
Limehouse

James Lee

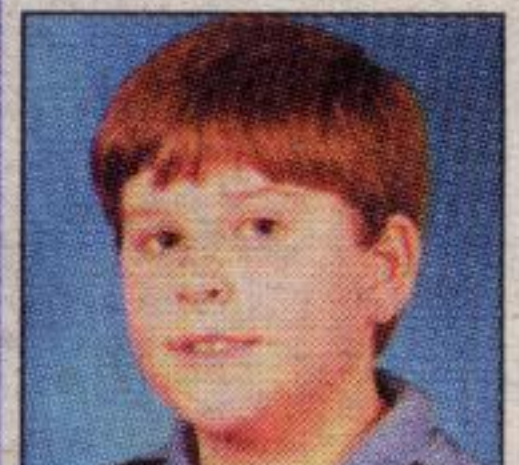
McKenzie-Smith Bennett

Greg Henry

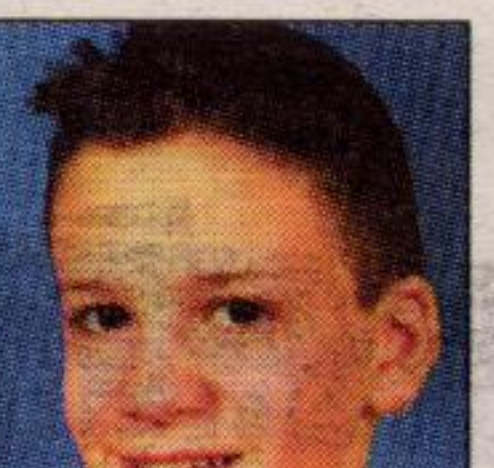
St. Joseph
