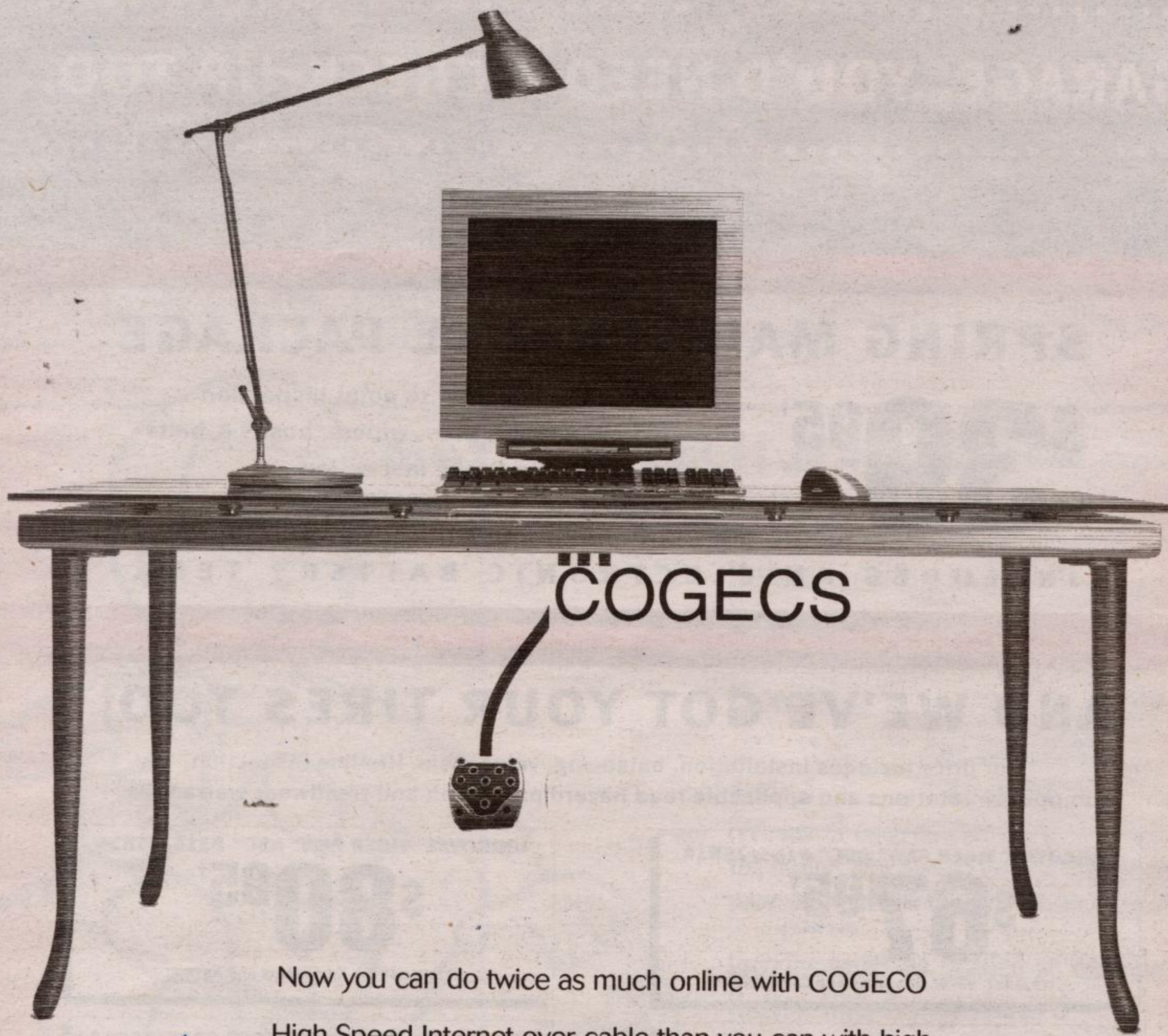
Another award for Achilles
