

### THE "CONSULTATION" APPOINTMENT

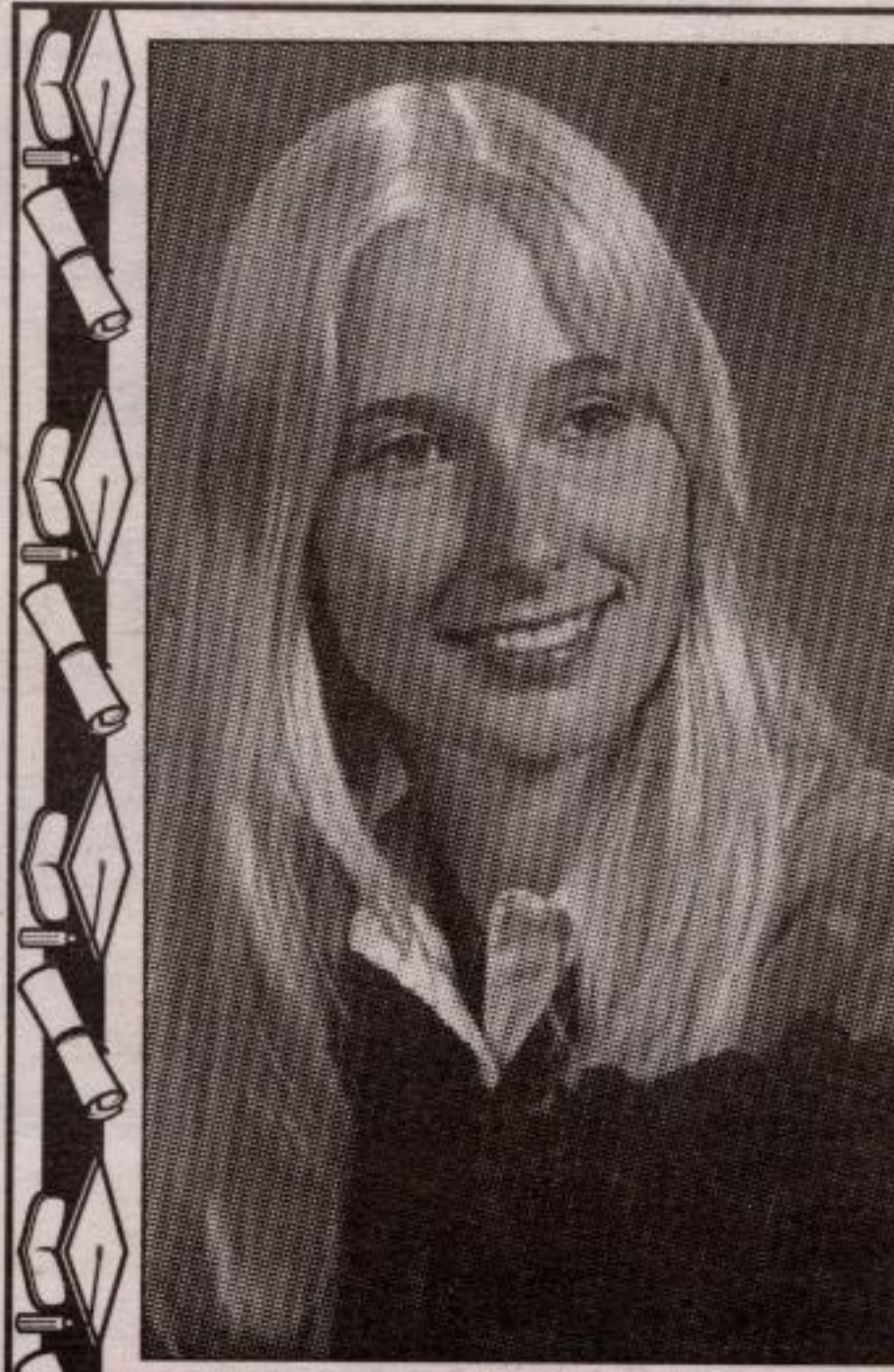
