Red Cross, fire department team up for disaster program

The North Halton Red Cross has signed on with the fire department to provide Red Cross' Personal Disaster Assistance program in Halton Hills. North Halton Red Cross and Halton Hills Fire Department recently signed a one-year Memorandum of Understanding to set out organizational responsibilities. The fire department contacted the Red Cross about the program after two major fires in Halton Hills last fall.

While the fire department is well-equipped to deal with emergencies, follow-up support for the victims of fires is lacking, according to a report written by the department's Chief of Operations, Larry Brassard.

"In our community, neighbours, friends and family members often step forward to lend a hand to those in need, just as they have done for decades. However, in some cases, even these resources are lacking or non-existent."

The North Halton Red Cross, with its recent opening of its office on Nipissing Rd. in Milton, is now able to offer its range of services more fully to the residents of Halton Hills, including the Personal Disaster Program, Brassard said.

This program will assist people by providing lodging, clothing, food, personal and family reunification and referral to other community agencies as required for the first three days after the disaster. The local branch is capable even "small scale disasters"—affecting up to 50 people.

The fire department's main contribution will be to provide training to the two Red Cross volunteers who will be liaising with the department.
