## Bruce Trail named Canada's top outdoor site

The Bruce Trail, which runs partially through Halton Hills, has been named the Best Natural Outdoor Site at the 2002 Attractions Canada National Awards.

The Bruce Trail is a public footpath, spanning 800 km in length, running along the Niagara Escarpment, from Niagara to Tobermory. In Halton Hills, the trail generally bisects the town, from Speyside area in the southwest through Limehouse to Terra Cotta in the northeast.

Only 47 per cent of the trail is on public land, the majority being routed on private land by informal handshake

agreements with landowners. Part of the Bruce Trail Association's mandate is to raise money to secure the trail through land purchase. Ancient Coast Wines has joined the cause, and will place the Bruce Trail logo on its bottle labels, with a portion of sales going to the association.

The Bruce Trail is Canada's only large-scale outdoor "attraction" maintained entirely by volunteers. Last year volunteers contributed more than 70,000 hours of service.
