## GLT's One-Act Play Festival will highlight local talent

Georgetown Little Theatre (GLT) will kick off its 2002-03 season with its second annual One-Act Play Festival.

Building on the success of last year's Festival, this event showcases the talents of first-time directors, actors and production crew. The performers run the gamut from 10 year olds making their stage debut to 77-year-old Ron Hunt, a veteran with over 100 GLT productions under his belt!

Four one-act plays will be presented, including:

- *The Queen's Music*, a comedy by Connor Snyder and directed by Cat Heaven. This play, which shows how the power of love — and music — really does triumph over all, includes a large cast of local youngsters aged 10 to 17.

- *Switching Places*, by Rex Deverill and directed by Sue Tolley also features four young performers. It is a comic and poignant look at first love and teen angst, aided and abetted by the machinations of a 'Heavenly' couple, with a surprising twist.

- *Superstar— Down at the End of Lonely Street*, directed by Mike Tadic, is an original play by Chicago-based playwright and musician, Gerry Lekas and offers a unique answer to all of those posthumous Elvis sightings reported by the tabloids— particularly timely in the wake of the 25th anniversary of The King's 'death'.

- *What Shall We Do With The Body?*, by Rae Shirley and directed by Ken Smith is a hilarious farce featuring a famous author, her secretary and a mysterious stranger. One of them is a murderer, recently escaped from a lunatic asylum— can you guess which one?
