Splitting classes a possibility Halton experiencing Kindergarten crush

allooning class sizes are an issue with many school boards in Ontario and Halton's public entity is no different.

Enrolment growth at the primary level in some schools has the Halton District School Board contemplating splitting some Junior and Senior Kindergarten classes to make them more manageable, which may result in teacher hirings.

There are some JK and SK classes brimming with as many as 33 little ones; there are several cases of classes in the low 30s.

The board's executive director of human resources said she doesn't know which schools in particular are well-beyond normal capacity but noted re-organizing staff and students is a common occurrence in the first few weeks of any new school year.

"With JK classes in particular we're see ing significant interest," said Dawn Beckett Morton. JK was brought back to the public board last year on a partial basis and is being fully implemented this year.

"Our collective agreement (with elemen tary teachers) uses 23 (pupils) as a guideline for Kindergarten. We always try to keep them smaller, but we do have some large classes out there.

"It could mean a large class with an edu cational assistant (added) or that we spli classes", which could entail the hiring o more Kindergarten teachers.

Her department should have a better handle on those staffing needs and schoo space availability by next week, said Beckett-Morton.


