



Before replacing your roof understand your roofing options

Is it time for a new roof on your home? If you are noticing that the shingles on Lyour roof are buckling or curling—or even worse that you are finding water spots on your ceiling- you may need to think about re-shingling.

Although new shingles can be applied over an existing layer if the surface is fairly flat, a build-up of more than two layers is considered too heavy for most homes to handle and results in a bumpy, somewhat uneven surface.

When you have your home re-shingled, the existing shingle layer is usually stripped off and a new one is installed. Most traditional shingles consist of pieces of felt or paper-coated with asphalt and granules. They come in different weights and colours and can last anywhere from about 12 to 25 years or more (depending on the quality of roofing you choose).

One of the biggest wear factors with asphalt shingles is sunlight. As a result, shingles located on the sides of your home which receive the most exposure to sunlight will tend to deteriorate more quickly.

As an alternative, you may want to consider wood shingles or shakes. These are considered to be more durable and likely to last longer than their asphalt counterparts, but they're more costly and they can become rotten if subject to too much moisture and shade.

Other alternative, but fairly costly roofing materials are concrete or clay tiles, and metal roofing. Concrete or clay tiles weigh more than traditional asphalt roofs but can last for several decades. They are not used as often

as other types of covering but create a very distinctive look. In recent years, new less costly products have been developed to mimic more expensive roofing materials like slate or cedar shake. A good roofing supply company can show you a selection of traditional shingles and alternatives.

Tar and gravel coverings have been used on flat roofs for many years. These multilayered coverings consist of layers of roofing with asphalt in between and asphalt and gravel on top.

Single ply roofs are a more recent option for flat roofs. They are generally made of modified asphalt or plastic or synthetic rubber. For more information about this and other types of roofing, talk to a roofer to see which type would best suit your home.

Prices can vary from roofer to roofer, so get quotes from a few contractors before making a choice. Be sure to ask if the price includes disposal and cleanup costs, and have that written into the contract. Disposal costs for an average-sized roof can be fairly hefty.

Also check into warranties offered. Generally, higher quality roof coverings have longer warranty periods, but compare carefully. Don't necessarily be swayed by the lowest quote. Look at the life expectancy and quality of the products being offered before making your final decision.

Also determine if the quote includes other related roofing items like the installation of new flashings and vents where required. After all, you don't want any extra little "surprises" down the road.
