## Two hurt. car crash


The provincial Special Investigations Unit (SIU) L is investigating a crash involving an unmarked police cruiser and a Chevrolet Tracker in Acton early Sunday morning in which a Halton police officer and Mississauga woman were injured.

Halton Police Const. Cyrus Irani, 27, the driver of the 2000 Ford police car, suffered leg injuries in the crash and a 45year-old Mississauga woman, who was a passenger in the rear seat of the Tracker, has a fractured wrist.

Halton Police report the officer was responding to a large disturbance outside Manny's Roadhouse on Mill St. at 2:45 a.m. when the vehicle, traveling west on Queen St., skidded on wet pavement while entering a curve at Young St., colliding with the eastbound Tracker.


