initially believed to have suffered head injuries in the crash and was transported to Georgetown Hospital. SIU spokesperson Rose Hong said Tuesday the woman, who was released from hospital, has been readmitted.

Irani was treated and released from hospital.

The driver of the Tracker, a 47-year-old Mississauga man, received minor injuries. A second female passenger in the Tracker wasn't injured.

Damage to the Tracker is estimated at \$20,000, and damage to the police vehicle at \$40,000.

Hong said the SIU is asking anyone who witnessed the accident or has information to call 1-800-787-8529 or 416-641-1879.

Four SIU investigators have been assigned to investigate the accident said Hong. She did not know how long the investigation would take.




