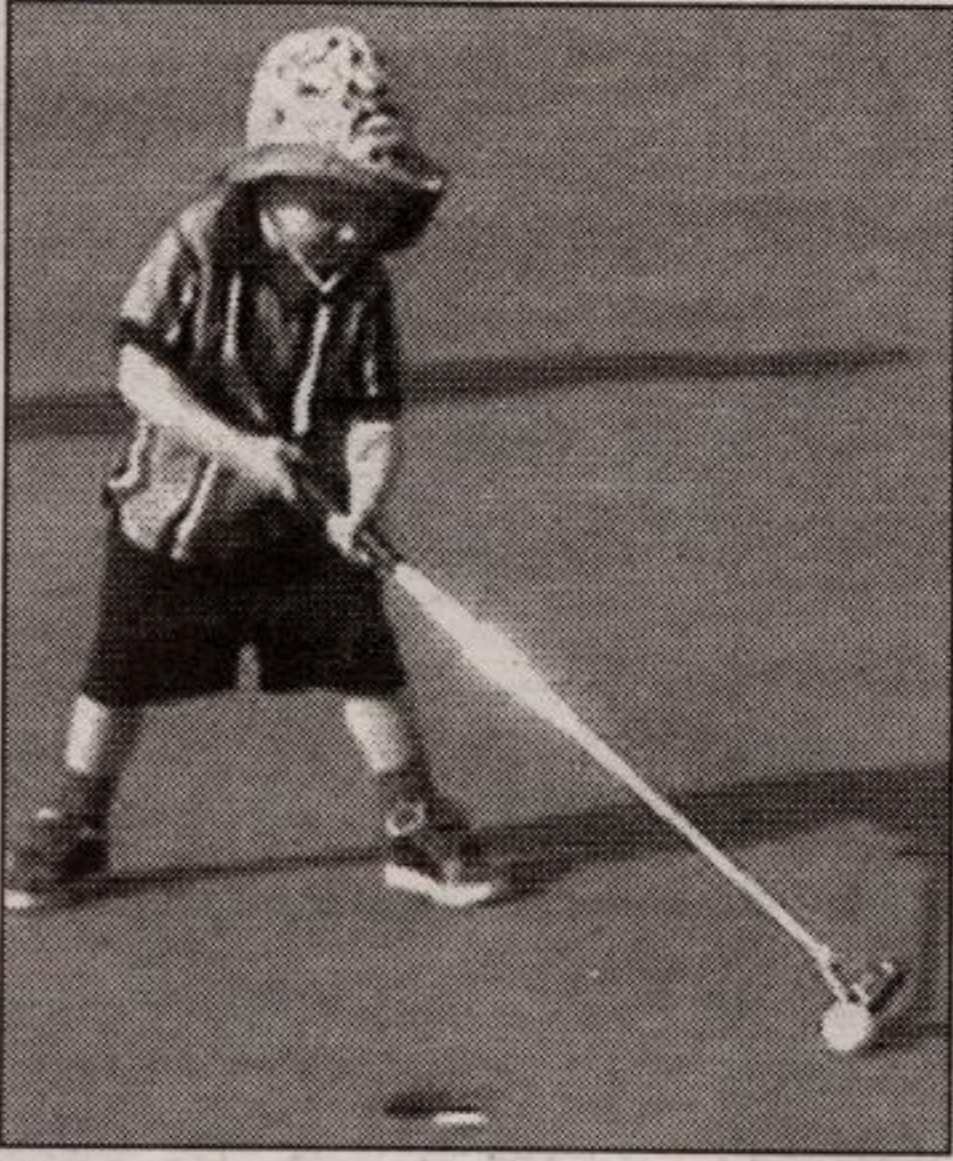


The First Annual Sean Doherty Invitational Golf Tournament

Region to hire more nurses

Halton Region is set to hire more long-term care (LTC) facility nurses and personal assistants thanks to a recent funding announcement by the Province.

"This is going to be a big boost (to our LTC facilities)," said Mary Beth Jonz, Halton's acting commissioner of health and social services.

Premier Ernie Eves announced \$100 million across the province in new LTC funding.

Initial estimates indicate the funding will result in an added \$6.33 per resident per day to pay for the new staff, added Jonz.

With the announced funding, a 15 per cent fee hike for LTC residents, that was set to take effect last Thursday, has been postponed. The hike would have resulted in an additional \$7 per day charge for residential care.

Instead, the fee hike will be phased in over three years. As of September 1, LTC facility residents can expect a \$3.02 per day rise in costs, with further increases coming over the next two years. The hike is intended to help pay for the increased personnel.

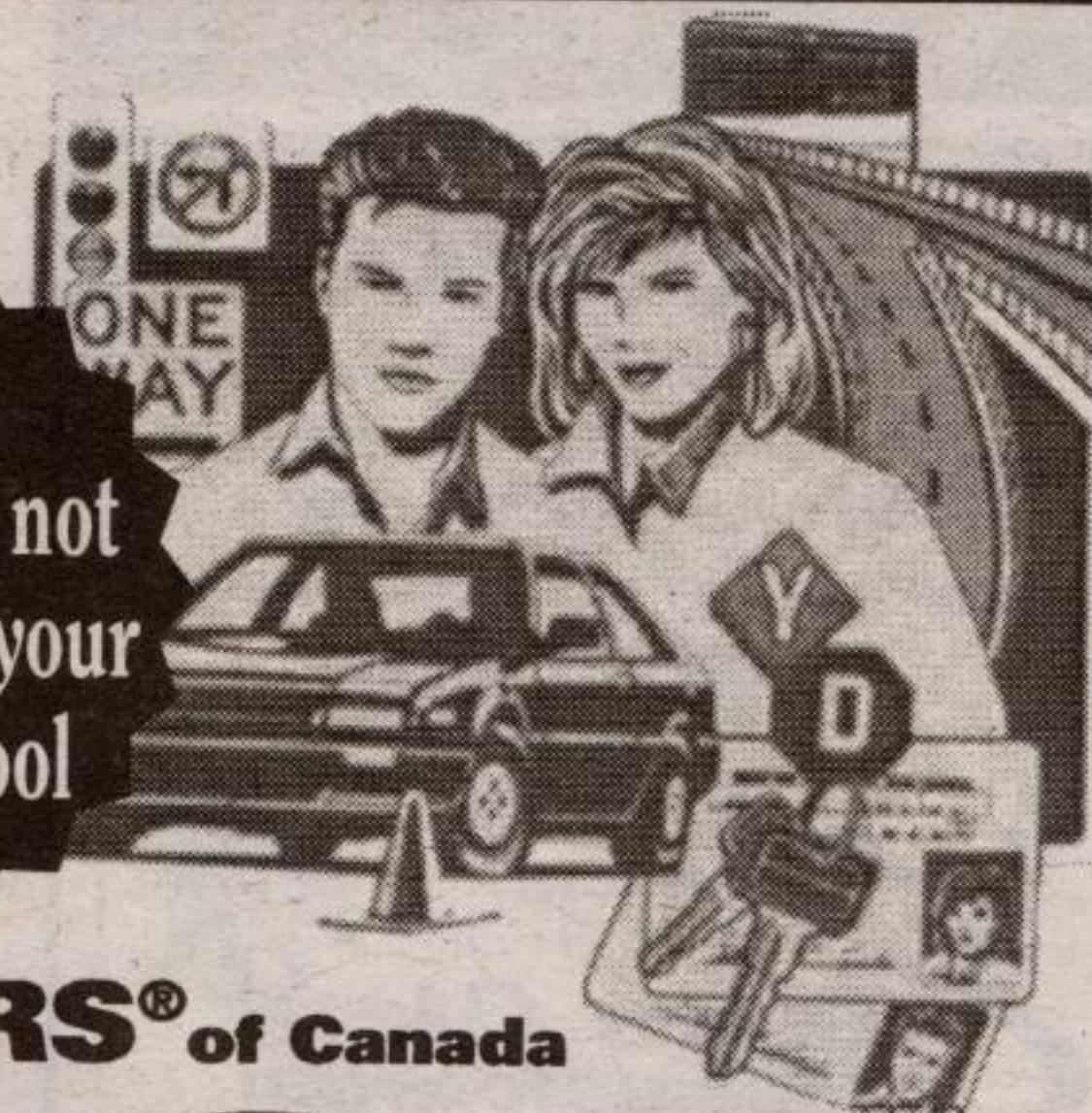
