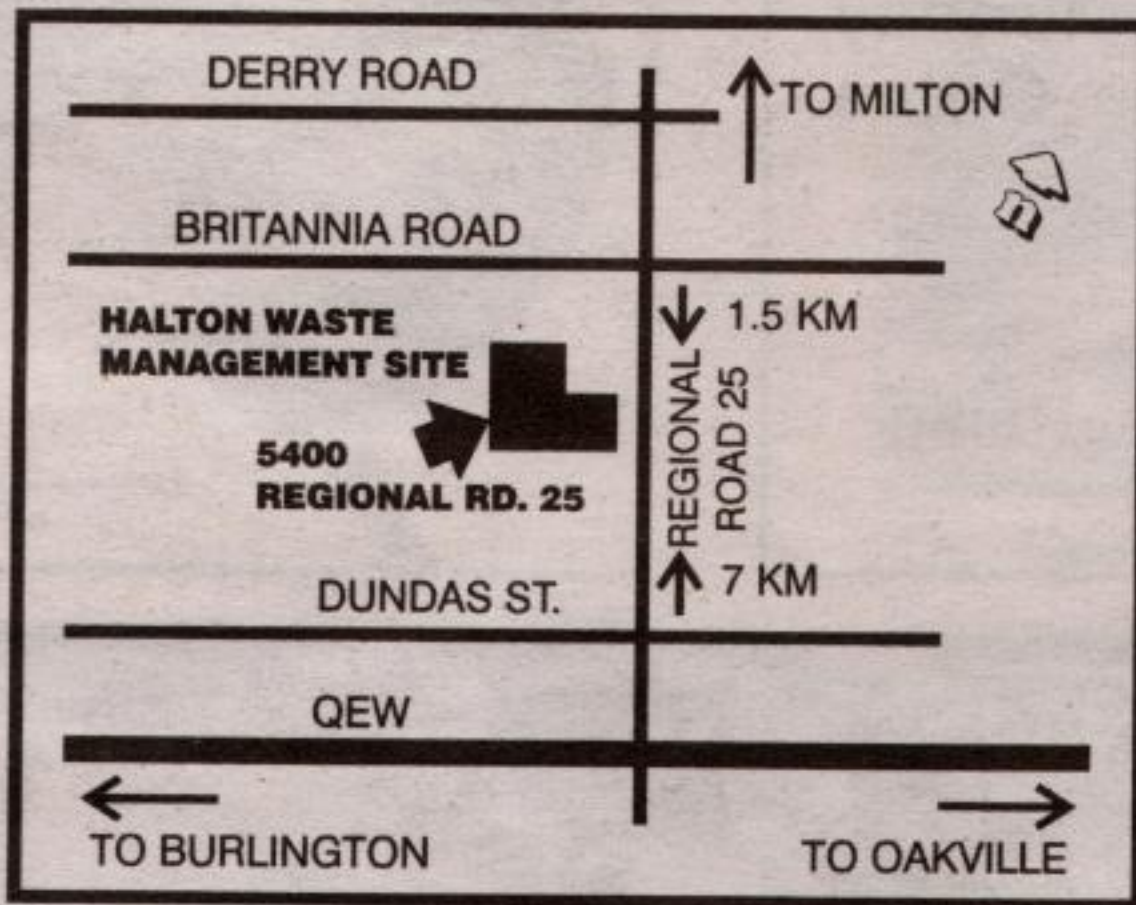

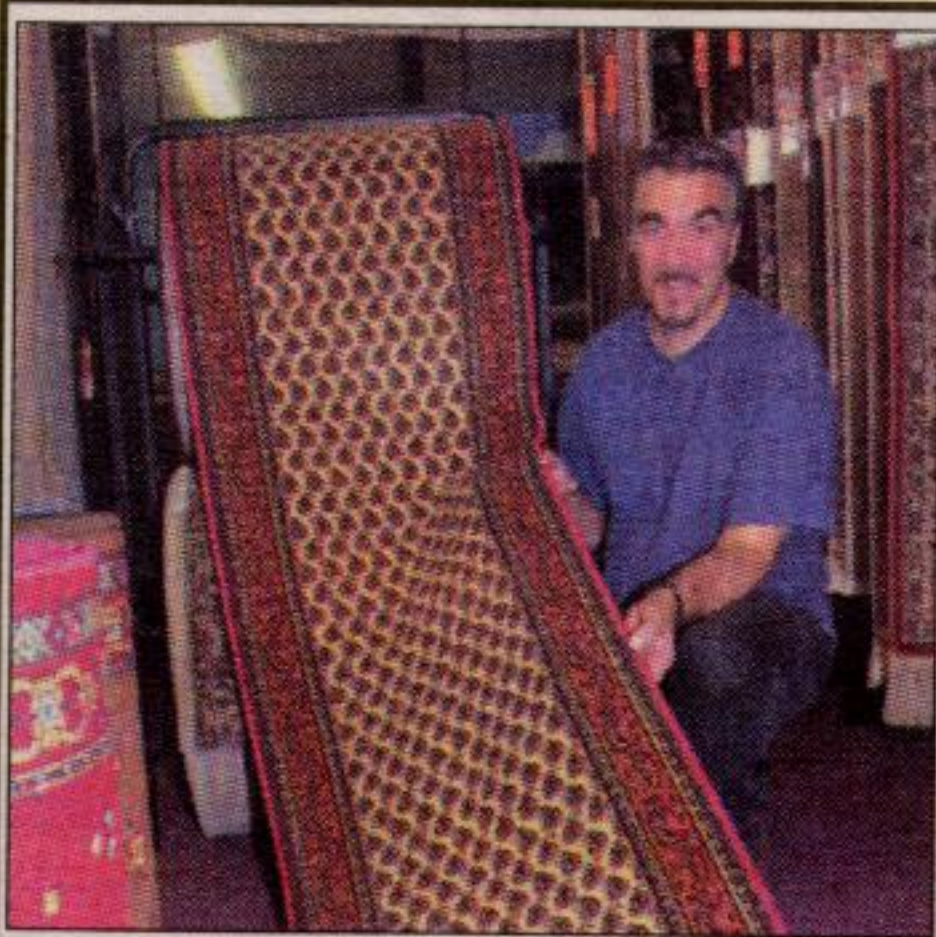

## Home Depot helps daycare build a wheelchair ramp

**H**ornby Co-op Nursery School now has a wheelchair ramp thanks largely to a program offered through Home Depot.

Through the program called Team Depot the ramp was built using volunteer labour from Home Depot employees who work at the Mississauga West store, along with volunteers from the nursery school. Home Depot donated the materials (approximately \$3,300 worth) and contracted a post hole company to install the supporting posts.

Sandra Pesce, whose son Andrew is in a wheelchair and attends the nursery school located in Hornby Community Centre, approached the store (located at Winston Churchill Blvd. and Britannia Rd.) last fall about the ramp after learning about Team Depot. After all the paperwork was completed, construction of the ramp began.

Norm Simas, hardware manager at

the Mississauga West Home Depot said three employees volunteered their time to build the ramp.

"Not only will this ramp benefit the wheelchair users, it will also be very beneficial to the many parents of babies and small children who unfortunately could not bring their strollers into the building," said Pesce, who added the Hornby Co-op is very grateful to the staff from the Mississauga West store for the generous donation.

The centre is also used for euchre by a seniors euchre group, a church group and for social functions. Pesce said the ramp will be welcomed by those who find steps a challenge.

Simas said the Hornby Co-op ramp is the third Team Depot project employees from the Mississauga store have been involved in. They participated in the recent Habitat for Humanity build in Toronto and in the construction of a peace garden at school.
