Ruth's long and difficult illness is now over. Always the struggle to breathe was made easier by the people who gathered around her but most often by the infinite patience of her husband and partner of the last 21 years, John Carter was the rock supporting the family; the love and friendship they shared was unsurpassed. His patience and gentleness with Ruth carried us all. 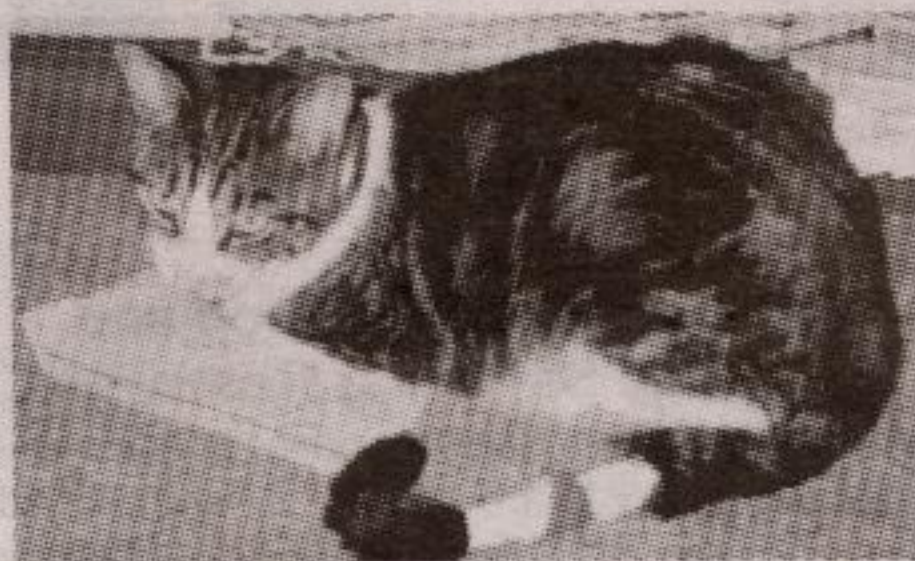
