

## Chapter of Canadian history to be presented at Cultural Centre

Canadian Federation of University Women—Georgetown presents Elizabeth Meyers-Cole portraying famed Canadian social justice advocate Agnes McPhail at the Halton Hills Cultural Centre on Tuesday, Oct. 1.

Meyers-Cole, a former journalist, brings to life the fascinating character of McPhail, Canada's first female member of Parliament. As the Grey County candidate for the United Farmers of Ontario, McPhail was elected in 1921 at the age 31 and continued in the public eye until her death in 1954.

McPhail used her oratorical skills and wit to express her ideas for social justice and to push for prison reform, international cooperation, improvements for farmers and rural life and a wider participation by women in public life.

This historical monologue will begin at 7:30 p.m.

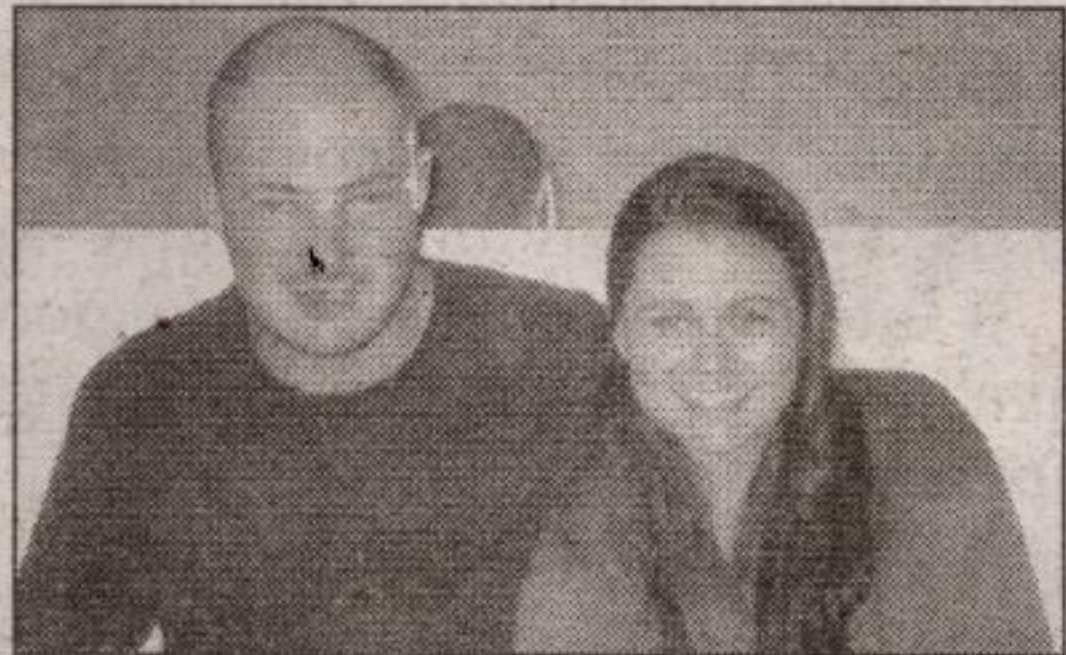
