HHCSI offers transitional housing for homeless

Halton Hills Community Support and Information (HHCSI), in partnership with the food banks, ministerial associations and Salvation Armies, operates two transitional housing units for homeless families.

These housing units are available to homeless families for a period of two months. During this two-

month period, families search for permanent housing without the added pressure of not knowing where they will spend the night.

Homelessness is particularly stressful for children—having to leave behind their familiar surroundings, going from one temporary place to another, having their furniture put into storage, and get-

ting used to new people and places over and over again. The goal of the transitional housing program is to offer a period of time where families can have some stability until they can find a permanent place to stay.

The funding comes from the federal government's Supporting Community Partnerships Initiative (SCPI). Transitional housing programs are operating in other parts of Halton as well through this initiative.

Volunteers have played a key role in this project right from the start. They have donated and stored furniture, helped pick up and deliver items to the apartments, and helped set up the apartments.

Since this program started, neither of the apartments have been empty. This speaks to the great need for temporary housing for homeless families. Families that have used the transitional housing units have been most grateful for their existence. Suicide prevention is theme of Mental Illness Awareness Week

Reach Out To Prevent Suicide is the theme of this year's Mental Illness Awareness Week, Oct. 6-12.

Suicide affects people of all ages and walks of life, but it is of particular concern for youth. It's the second leading cause of death for youth and the only age group in Canada where the rate is on the rise. Recent research shows that Canadian youth are at a disturbingly high risk for mental health problems. Ontario youth have a much higher incidence of mental disorders than the provincial average.

Youth Net Halton/Talking about Mental Illness is a free program for youth offered in Halton high schools and other places where youth can be found. Trained youth facilitators lead discussion groups talking about healthy coping strategies and youth-friendly resources.
