Region OKs public defibrillator plan

Public access defibrillators (PADs) may soon be coming to a municipal building near you. Halton regional council recently endorsed a proposed to initiate a PAD program, pending 2003 budget approval.

The program would see compact computerized defibrillation machines situated in public areas in case of a cardiac arrest. Prior to any PADs being installed around the region, a steering committee would be established to determine the most suitable locations.

Initial locations would likely include municipal offices, recreational facilities and malls.

Each PAD machine costs about \$5,000. An additional 1.5 full-time employees would also be needed to run the program.
