Doors open at 2:30 p.m. Admission is \$5 and light refreshments will be served.

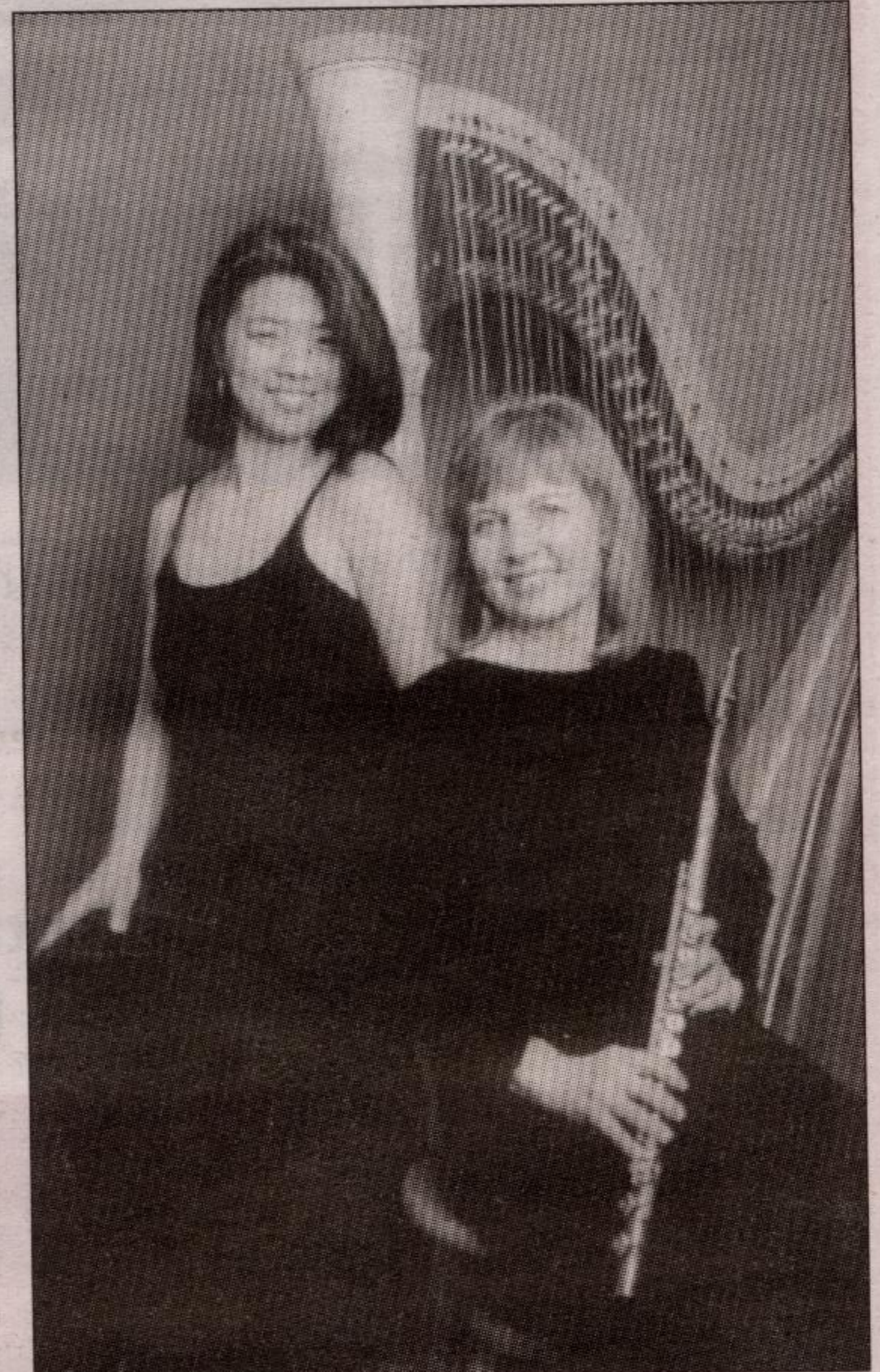
Arts Alive is a group of volunteers promoting the arts community and events in Halton Hills.
