

# Halton Region wants to 'connect' with the public

The public is being asked to provide input into a community vision for Connecting Halton— an initiative to create and implement a vision of the future that involves the use of information and communication technologies in new and innovative ways.

The public meeting in Halton Hills will be held on Tuesday, Nov. 5 from 7:30-9:30 p.m. in the council chambers at the Halton Hills Civic Centre.

"This project will allow us to interconnect our lives and our services through a single Internet por-

tal," said Joyce Savoline, Halton Regional Chairman. "Once complete, it's hoped the initiative will enhance local economic development, make government services more accessible and improve the quality of life in Halton."

Recent funding from the Province enables the Connecting Halton project to build a vision for better health care delivery, education, community services, government, and business opportunities.

The Connecting Halton Steering Committee, chaired by Halton Region, is composed of 23 represen-

tatives from a wide variety of sectors such as education, health, police, municipal and regional governments, utilities, libraries, business, environment, and agriculture.

Following the public meetings, all of the ideas will undergo a technical review to assess their feasibility.
