A jam-packed day of activities for the whole family is the usual fare at the Acton Leathertown Festival held the first Sunday after the Civic Holiday weekend. Next year, the 12th annual event will be held on Sunday, August 10, 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.

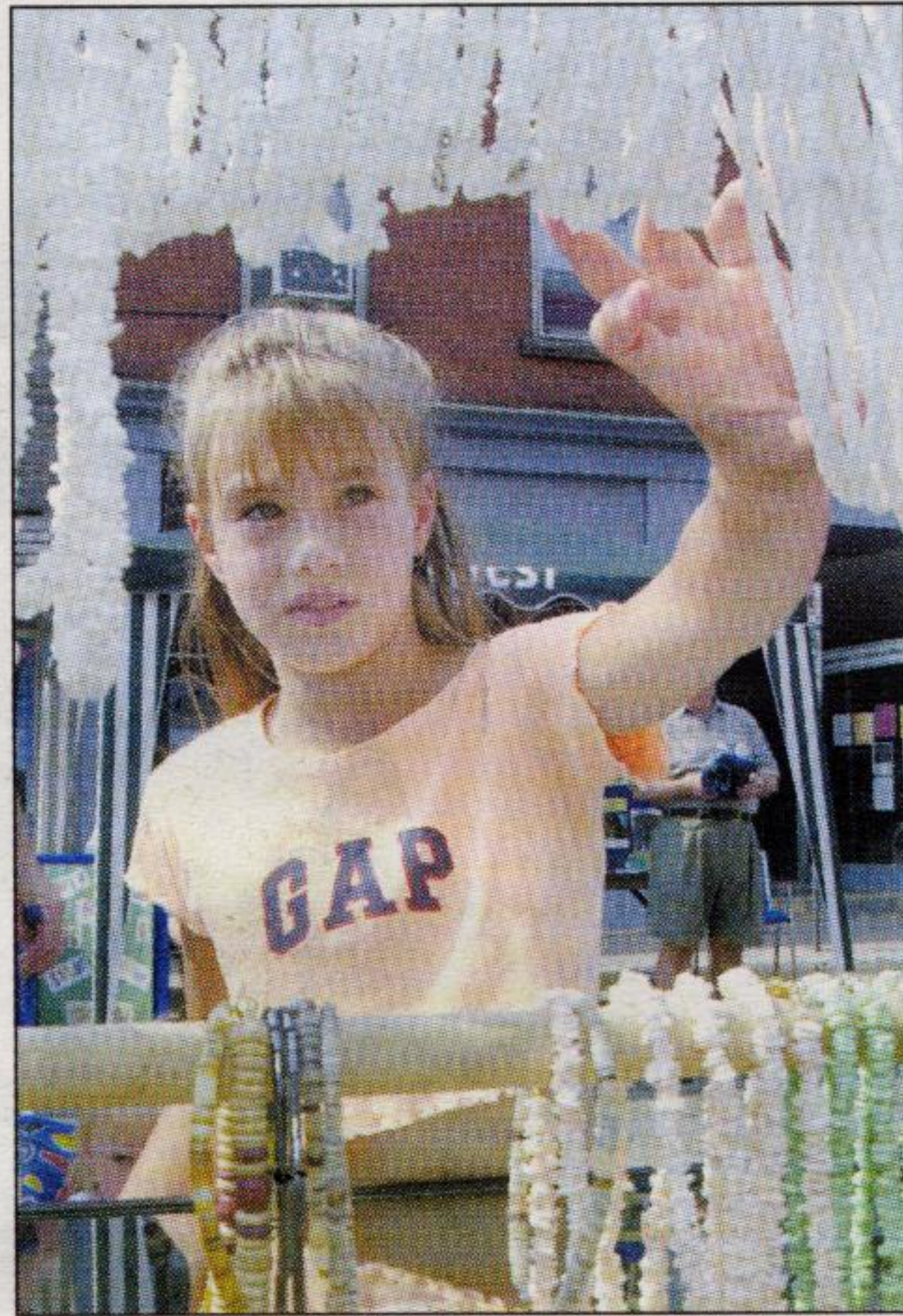
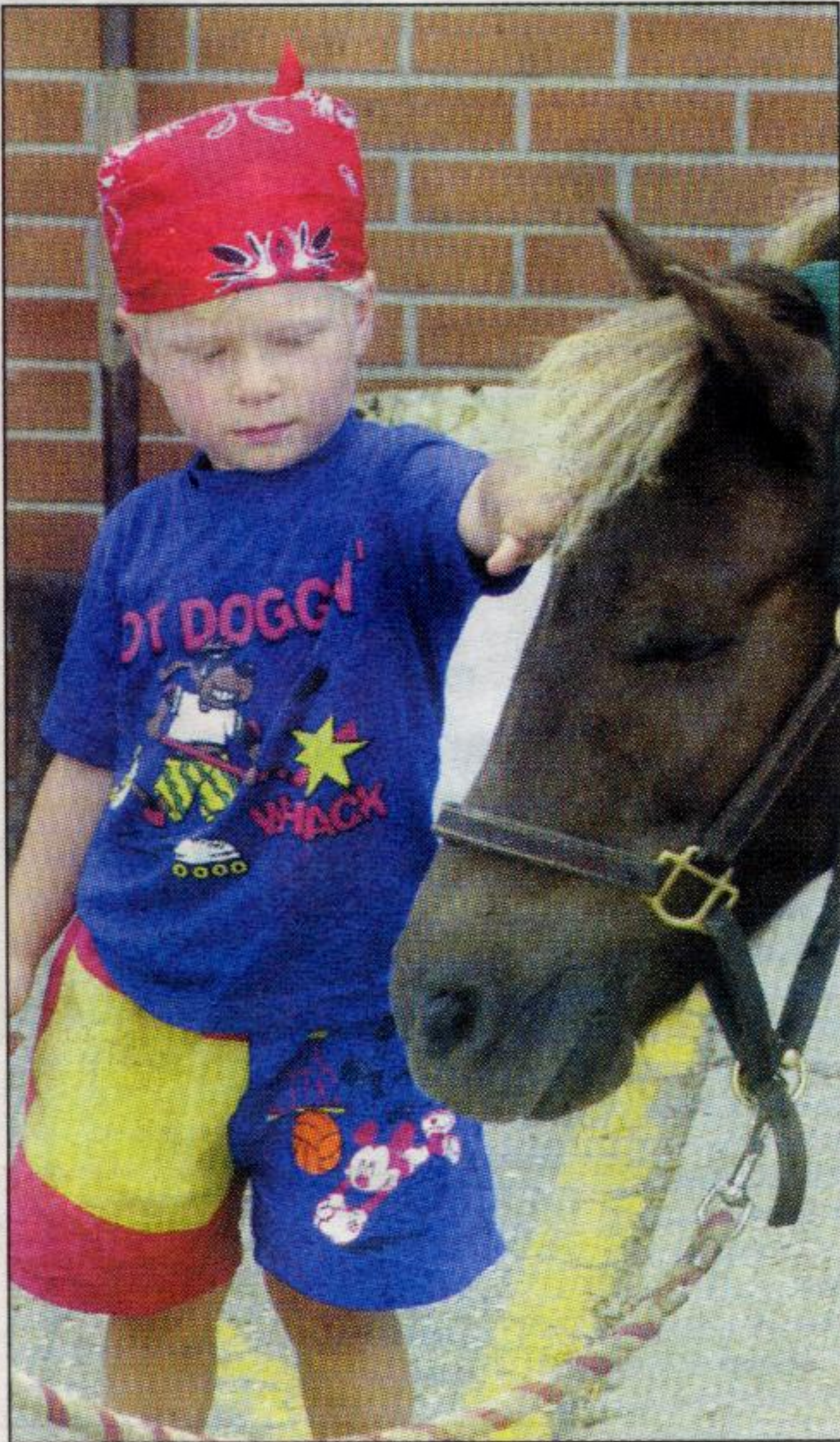
The festival celebrates the town's historical past in the leather industry. It includes more than 150 vendors selling their wares along the six streets surrounding Mill St. which is closed during the festival to create a large pedestrian mall. Local merchants hold

special sidewalk sales and live music and dancers perform on a stage in addition to the multitude of street buskers. Events in past years have included dog shows, skateboarding and rock climbing wall for teens and for the younger crowd, a children's village including pony rides, carnival rides, face painting, clowns, and more.

And of course, there will be plenty of food including waffles and ice cream, pizza and barbecue.
