

Riverfest

Growing in popularity every year, is Riverfest, a festival celebrating life on the Credit River in the village of Norval each May.

The focus is on enjoying the outdoors and educating residents about the importance of protecting the river by living in harmony with nature. The day includes a vendor market, barbecue, fly fishing demonstration, birdwatching, boat and camping displays, book signings, Bruce Trail hike, kids' activity centre, and live music.

The majority of the attractions and events take place in Norval Park and Willow Park Ecology Centre off Mary St. However, some will also take place at Canoe Country Outdoor Shop and McNabb Park.

All activities are within walking dis-

tance in the small village, east of Georgetown. Information centres are set up in front of the Norval Convenience Store and at the entrance to Norval Park where attendees can gather information, maps, and brochures. Information can also be obtained at Canoe Country prior to the event as well.

Riverfest is a great time to explore this pretty little village. You can picnic in McNabb Park and walk along the river trail behind Canoe Country, or enjoy the heritage flowers and the unique analematic sundial (a sundial showing latitude and meridan—there's only seven in North America) in the Montgomery Garden in front of Norval Park.
