## Georgetown Fall Fair



Although the Georgetown Fall Fair has evolved over the past 156 years, organizers have managed to add to the event without detracting from its roots.

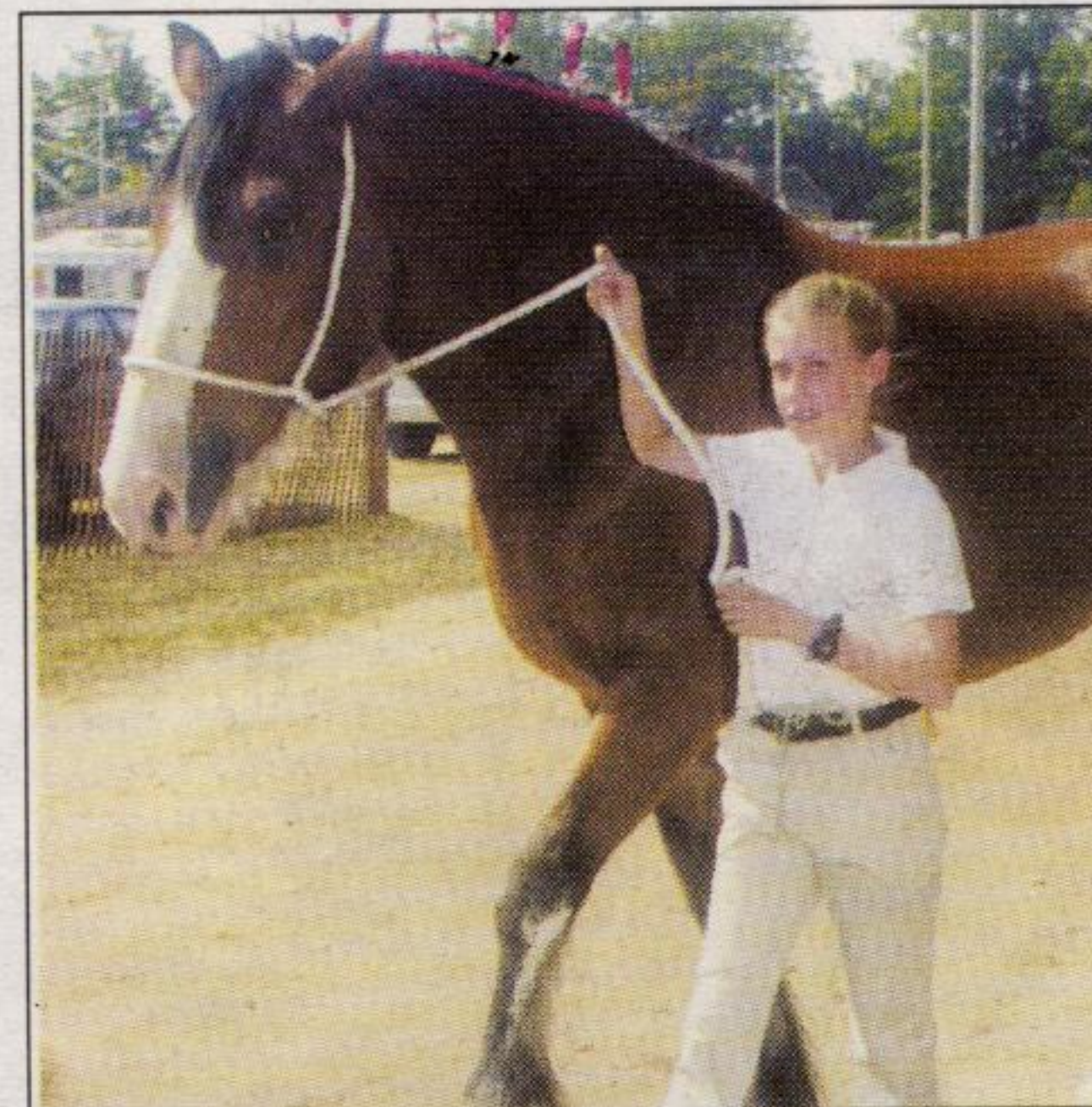
While some fairs have moved away

from the agricultural aspect, Georgetown Fall Fair has always kept the rural side in the fair so the event is a mix of "rural meets urban."

Popular events at the fair, which draws between 10,000 and 12,000 people each year, include the midway which doubled in size four years ago, Georgetown Fair Ambassador Competition, Agriculture Awareness Tent, homecrafts exhibits, Kinsmen Girls' Softball, heavy and English horse shows, the demolition derby, kiddie tractor pull and sheep dog, horseshoeing, children's pet show, the poultry show and sheep-shearing demonstrations.

Next year's fair, the 157th edition, is set for Friday, Saturday, Sunday, September 5, 6, and 7.
