Entertainment

Halton Hills is rich in the performing arts, having numerous groups which specialize in different types of entertainment.

Georgetown Little Theatre is the longest running group, having celebrated more than 40 years of theatre in the Halton Hills area. The group produces three plays a season, beginning in November, with a winter play in February, and an early spring production to wind up the season.

GLT's high quality plays generally feature smaller casts of four to six players, with elaborate sets and costumes, encompassing all types of plays, including comedy, suspense and drama.

The 2002-2003 GLT season features the hilarious comedy, Don't Dress for Dinner in November, murder mystery Out of Sight, Out of Murder in February 2003, and a drama My Darling Judith, opening in April of 2003.

The group rehearses out of their newly constructed studio in Stewarttown, and perform all their plays at John Elliott Theatre, located at the Halton Hills Cultural Centre at 9 Church St. in Georgetown.

If toe-tapping Broadway musicals are your cup of tea, then Georgetown Globe Productions is the group to see. Globe takes on three major musical productions a season, as well as a musical cabaret-style extravaganza in January, usually featuring a theme of certain types of music.

A cast and chorus of more than 40 onstage is the norm for any Globe Production, and the musicals always bring rave reviews.

The 2002-2003 season will feature Evita in November, a cabaret entitled Hooked On a Feeling II in January 2003, and The King and I in May 2003. All musicals, with the exception of Hooked On a Feeling II, are performed at John Elliott Theatre.


