GLT's comedy opens this week

It's curtain time as Georgetown Little Theatre's production of *Don't Dress For Dinner* by Marc Camoletti, adapted by Robin Hawdon gets set to open at the John Elliott Theatre on Thursday, Nov. 7.

This French farce, originally titled *Pyjamas Pour Six*, is directed by GLT's Mark Tiller. His previous directorial credits include *Lend Me A Tenor* and *The Odd Couple—Female Version*.

The play is set in a stylishly converted French farmhouse, where Bernard (played by Paul d'Entremont) is hoping to entertain his chic, Parisian mistress (Julia Guthrie) for the weekend. He has arranged for a cordon bleu cook (Elizabeth Barfoot) to provide a delectable meal, is in the process of packing his wife, Jacqueline (Margaret Brady) off to her mother's, and has even invited his best friend Robert (David Brock) along as a suitable alibi. He's got everything under control, what could possibly go wrong?

What if Robert shows up without knowing why he's been invited? What if Robert and Jacqueline are secretly lovers? What if the cook is mistaken for the mistress and the mistress can't
