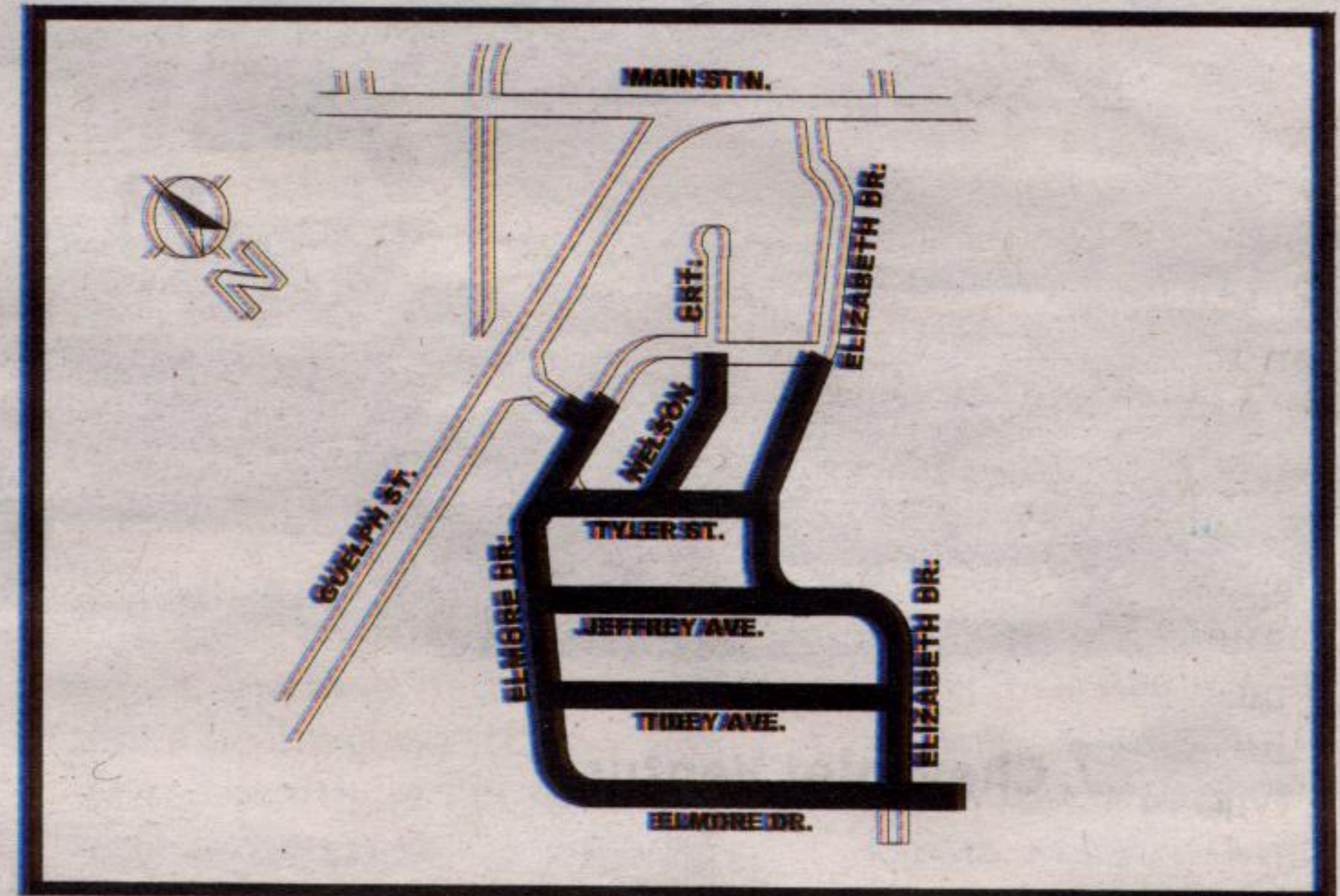

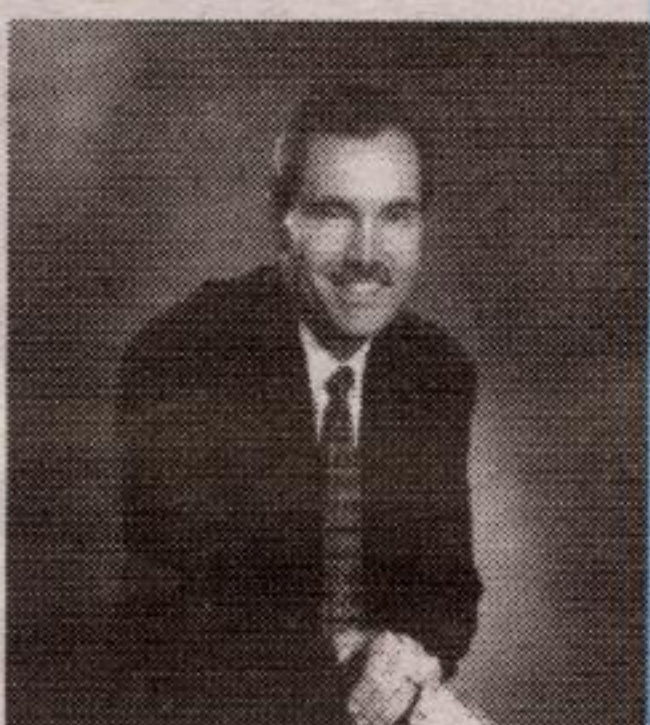
There's still time to get your flu shot
