Raiders land tough winger in Jr. A swap

evin Harvey built a reputation as one tough L customer in the Provinicial Junior A Hockey League but the Georgetown Raiders hope to show another side to their newest acquisition.

The 18-year-old winger, acquired from the Oakville Blades in exchange for defenceman Mike Swinton and cash, was averaging better than a point a game with 21 points in 18 games for the Blades. He had also racked up 123 minutes in penalties to lead Oakville by more than 50 minutes.

"He's a skilled hockey player," said Raider GM Jack Moon. "Our goal is to keep him on the ice more."

Moon said he expects Harvey to continue to play a physical game and create more space for Georgetown's smaller forwards, but doesn't want to see him in the role of team policeman.

"He's an in-your-face player and his only problem in the past has been after the whistle. We hope to get a little more out of him. We don't need another enforcer."

Georgetown hosts Hamilton Saturday (7:30 p.m. at the Alcott Arena) but Harvey is not expected to make his Raider debut until Monday's rematch with the Kilty Bees in Hamilton.

Swinton, 17, had three goals seven points in 21 games for the Raiders.

In a separate deal, the Raiders sent 6'2" defenceman Kyle Aitken to Aurora for cash.

Aitken was a solid offensive contributor with four goals and 18 points in 20 games, but Moon said the Raiders hope to bring in a defender who is a little stronger in his own end.

The defenceman had also expressed an interest in playing closer to his home in Pickering.


Others turning in strong performances included: Kailin Brown (fourth in senior bronze freeskate); Alexandra Collis (fourth in freeskate and seventh in elements);
