

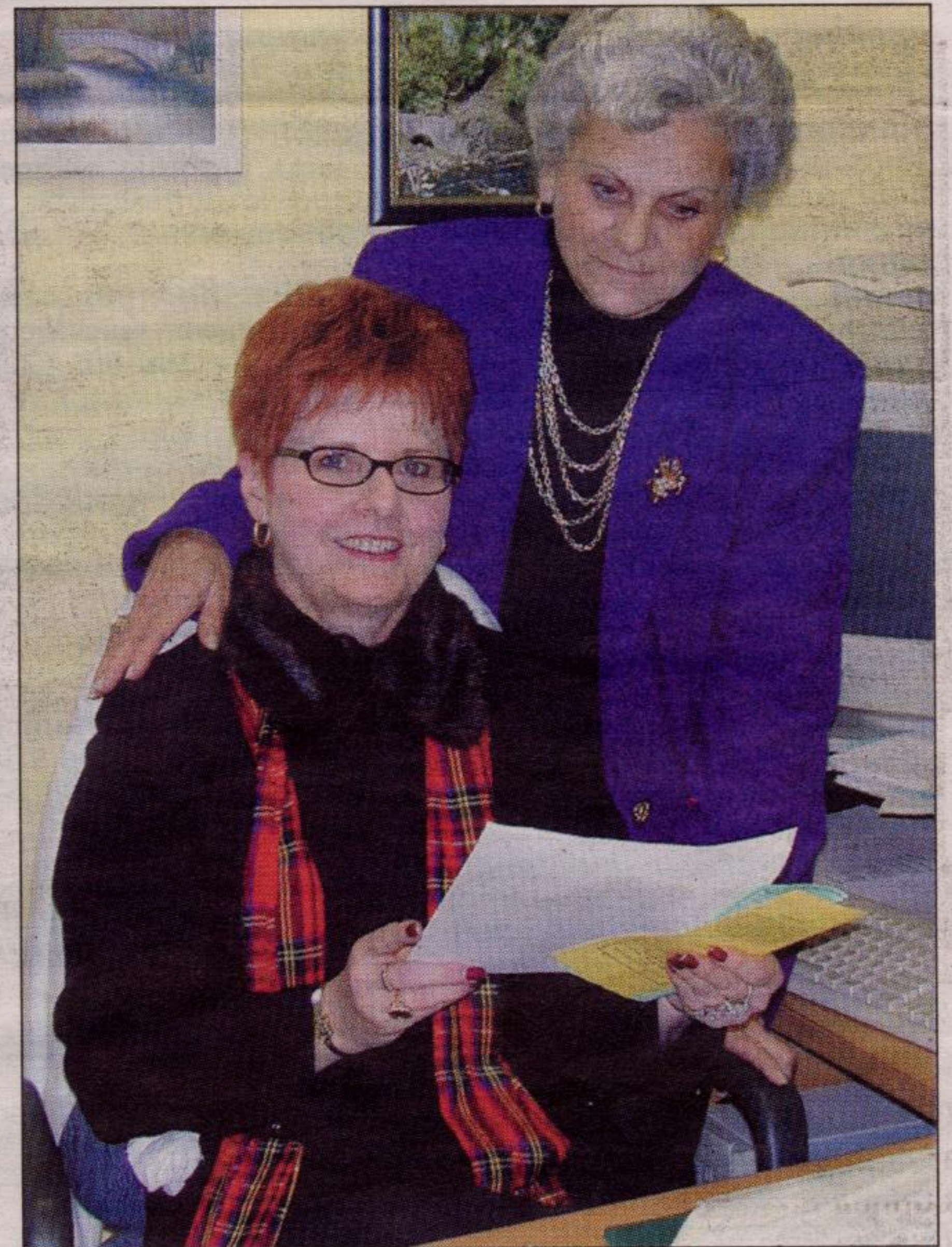


Air cadets honoured

Operating hours to expand at local CAS-HH office

Beginning next week the Cancer Assistance Services of Halton Hills (CAS-HH) office in Georgetown will be open five days a week.

Currently, the office, located at 72 Mill St., Suite 207, is open three days a week but due to growing patient care needs and the workload the office hours will be extended to five days (9 a.m. to 5 p.m.) beginning December 2.

"The demands of the patients has increased a hundred fold," said CAS-HH executive director Sheila Smith. She said at times they are getting three new patients and 38 to 55 calls a day. She added approximately four to five cars a day driven by volunteer CAS-HH drivers are taking area patients for cancer treatment.

"We're really concentrating on personal service," said Smith.

Louise Brown, CAS-HH patient services chair, said there is currently a need for volunteers in various areas including babysitting (for moms with cancer who need help with their children), drivers and palliative care.

CAS-HH also has wigs and turbans available, and walkers and hospital beds can be borrowed.

The organization also provides information to cancer patients about other organizations and agencies that may be able to help them.

"The community support is just unbelievable," said Brown.

"It's been incredible," said Smith. "Without them we wouldn't be able to do any of this."

Due to the amount of money raised from the community this year CAS-HH was able to donate \$10,000 to the Georgetown Terry Fox Run, and \$5,000 each to breast cancer and prostate cancer research at Princess Margaret Hospital.
