**NOTICE OF APPLICATION
FRANCHISE APPROVAL FOR
THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF HALTON**

Union Gas Limited ("Union") has filed an application, dated June 18, 2002, (the "Application") with the Ontario Energy Board ("the Board") under the *Municipal Franchises Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. M.55, as amended, for an order of the Board approving the terms and conditions upon which and the period for which the Corporation of the Regional Municipality of Halton (the "Corporation"), is by by-law (the "By-law") to grant to Union the right to construct and operate works for the distribution of gas, and the right to extend and add to the works in the Regional Municipality of Halton (the "Municipality").

Union has also applied for an order of the Board declaring and directing that the assent of the electors of the Municipality to the By-laws is not necessary.

Union is presently serving the municipality and has a certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (F.b.C. 192) for the Municipality. Union's franchise agreement with the Corporation expired on August 16, 1987. Union has a perpetual Transmission Agreement with the Municipality dated April 13, 1954.
