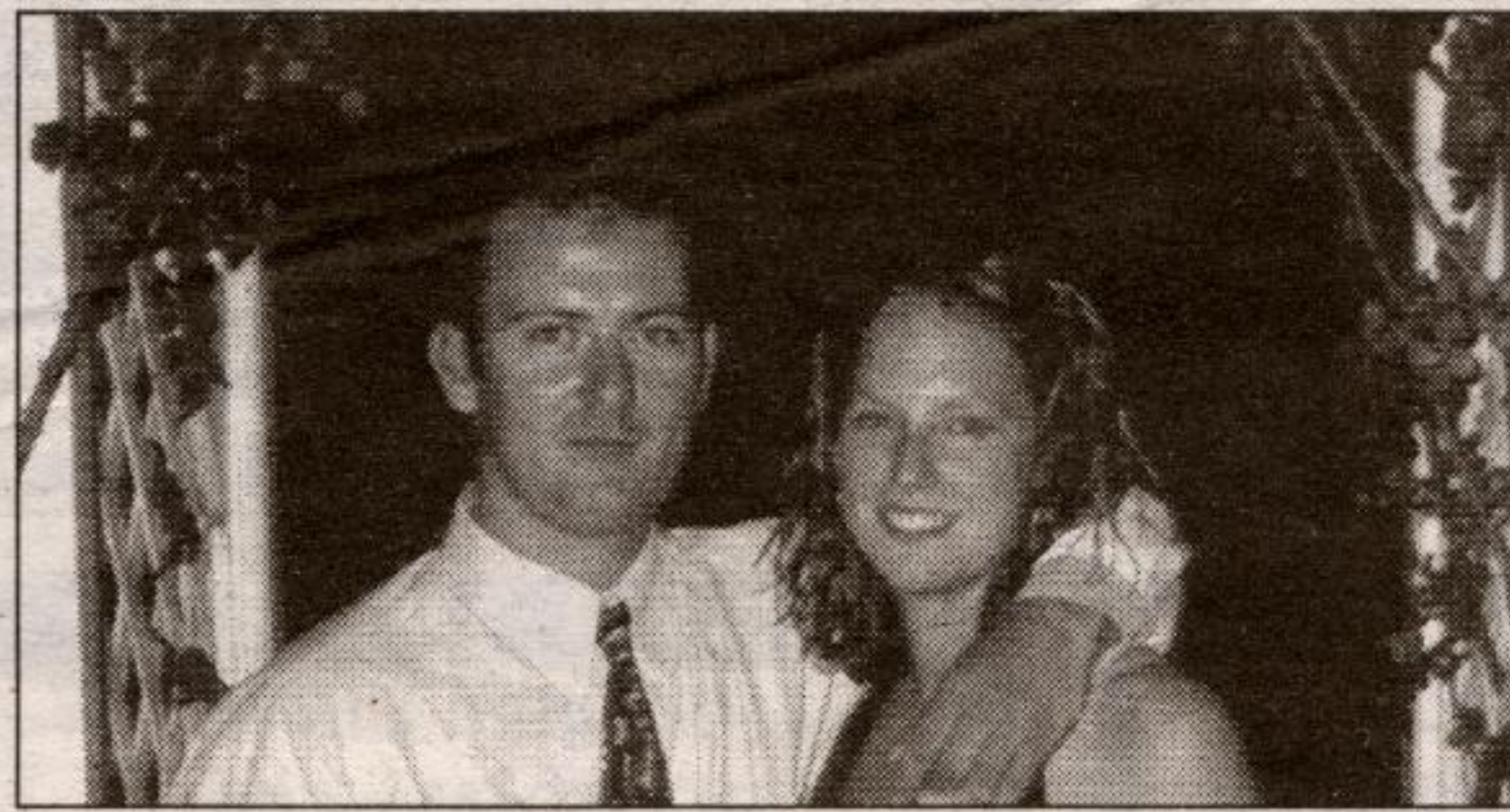


Spring awakening
