Our elevator is working but we are waiting for the back door to finish.

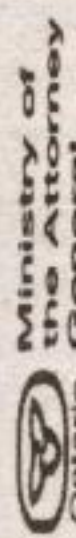
The Monday night cribbage team held its banquet upstairs. The Ladies Auxiliary catered
