## Glen Williams featured in book

Historian Ron Brown highlights Glen Williams's Main St. in a new book, *Downtown Ontario—Unusual Main Streets to Explore*.

The village is among 50 towns and cities featured.

Entitled "Old Mills, New Life", Brown's three-page chapter on Glen Williams starts with "Almost lost amid Georgetown's urban sprawl, the valley village of Glen Williams exudes a distinctly mill town ambience, little changed over the decades. Its winding streets and historic buildings, all nestled in the valley of the Credit River, represent an oasis away from the urban tedium which lies literally above the hill."

Brown is also the author of *Ghost Towns of Ontario: A Field Guide* and *The Last Stop* (which featured Georgetown's railway station). The book, published this month by Polar Bear Press, sells for \$22.95.
