

The Council of the Regional Municipality of Halton, through its Planning and Public Works Committee, will be holding a public meeting pursuant to Section 26 (1) of the Planning Act, to provide those interested an opportunity to comment on the need to revise the Region's Official Plan. The final staff recommendations on the Regional Official Plan Review "Directions Report" will be considered by Planning and Public Works Committee on the evening of Wednesday, June 18, 2003 and by Regional Council on the evening of Wednesday, June 25, 2003, in the Halton Region Council Chambers.




GDHS students become 'Earth Angels'
