Better education

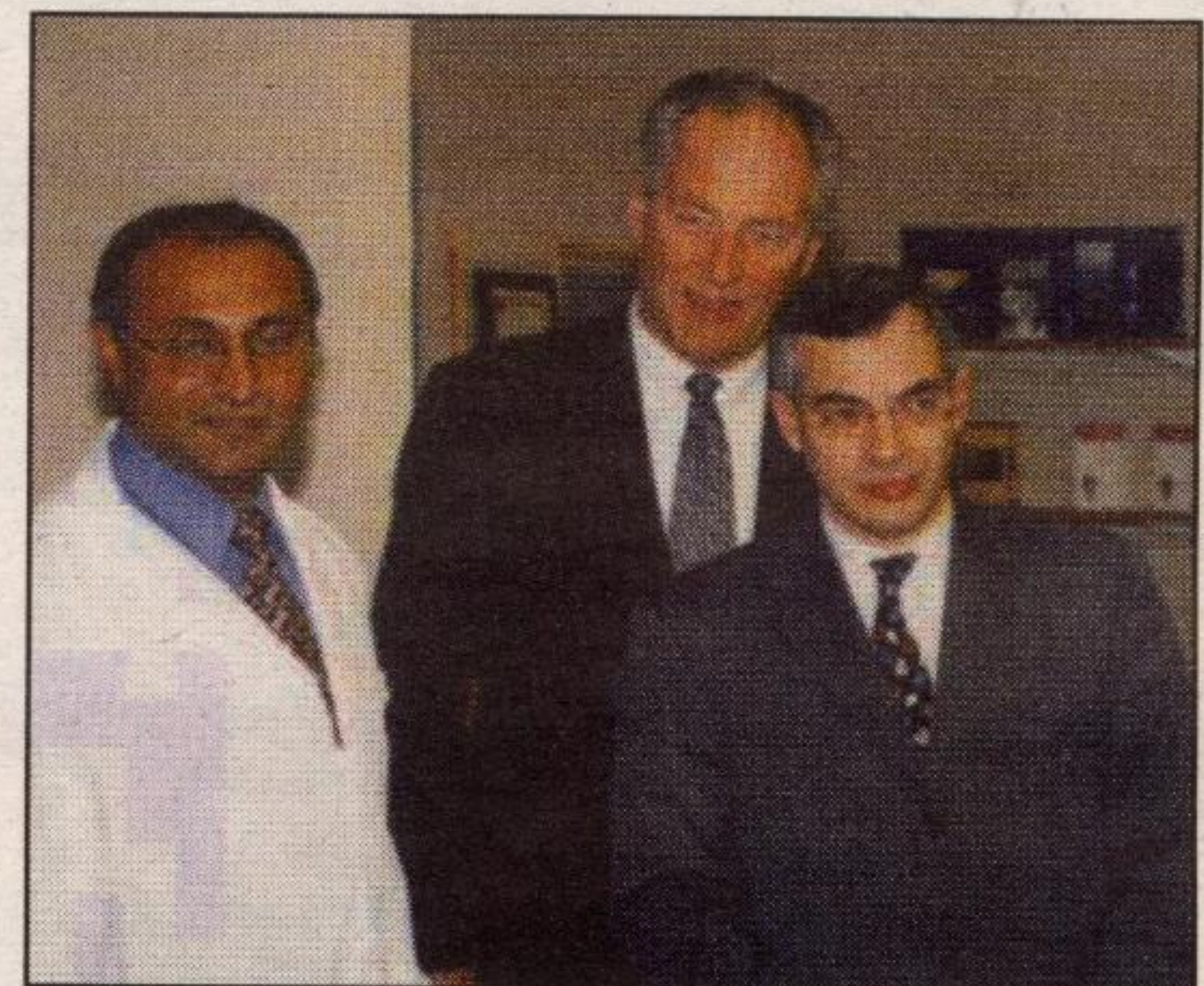
- Giving you the choice of which school in your district your children attend
