

### Country show heats up JET Saturday.


An Evening Of Country Music showcases three unique and talented groups performing their versions of country music, 8 p.m. at the John Elliott Theatre on Saturday, May 24.



#### NOTICE OF PROPOSED STREET NAME CHANGES

Due to concerns with the 9-1-1 Emergency Response Service, Bell Canada has informed the Town of Halton Hills that it must take steps to eliminate duplicate addresses in our municipality. These duplicate addresses were created when Acton, Georgetown and Esquesing Township were amalgamated into the Town of Halton Hills in 1974. Changing technology, such as the use of cell phones and telephone number portability has resulted in a need for distinct municipal addresses.

The Town of Halton Hills is currently investigating the proposed re-naming of the following streets to eliminate duplicated addresses in Halton Hills:

Park Avenue, Acton Main Street North, Acton Main Street South, Acton Mary Street, Norval Arthur Street, Norval George Street, Acton
