

Outhouses to hit Main St. in CAS-HH's crazy fun race

Some unusual-looking vehicles will take to the streets in downtown Georgetown next Saturday (May 31) for Cancer Assistance Services of Halton Hills' (CAS-HH) First Annual Crazy Outhouse Race.

The outhouses on wheels, built by the participants, will race Saturday on Main St., which will be closed to traffic between Church St. and James St. The event is designed to be fun for everyone and provide CAS-HH with the opportunity to

raise awareness of their services and educate the public on cancer treatment and prevention.

The event will begin at 8 a.m. with outhouse registration and photos to run until 9:30 a.m.

At 8:30 a.m. people can stop by the McGibbon Hotel for a pancake breakfast and anytime between 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. everyone is encouraged to stop by CAS-HH's cancer information booth.

Other events scheduled include the

parade of outhouses at 9:30 a.m., Toonie in the Toilet toss for prizes at 10 a.m., children's face-painting and balloons from 10 a.m. to noon, Crazy Outhouse Race preliminary heats from 10 a.m. to 11 a.m., the Celebrity Toilet Paper Toss at 11 a.m., a baked bean luncheon at the McGibbon Hotel from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., Crazy Outhouse Race semi-final heats from 12:30 to 1 p.m., the Crazy Outhouse Race final at 1:15 p.m. followed by the award presentation at 1:30 p.m.

Art Howell, the CAS-HH director who came up with the idea for the outhouse race, called it "just a fun event."

Organizers are hoping many outhouses are entered and suggest residents of one street challenge those of another in the race, along with service clubs and bars. Each outhouse should have a theme and the team pushing it should be dressed accordingly. There is no entrance fee.
