**Learn more about policing
 Citizen Police Academy starts Sept. 9**

Anyone interested in learning more about policing in Halton should consider attending the Citizen Police Academy (CPA) set to begin this month.

The academy, which will begin Sept. 9 at Halton Regional Centre (1151 Bronte Rd. in Oakville), will consist of 12 sessions designed to give participants a first-hand look at the life of a police officer and provide them with a better understanding of the services provided to the Halton community.

Topics will include live demonstrations from the public safety unit, Tactical and Rescue Unit (TRU), Communciation Bureau, Polygraph Unit and a special opportunity for you to participate in a live scenario. Other topics include the Drug

and Mortality Unit, Intelligence Bureau, Terrorism, Fraud, Major Crime Unit and many other police bureaus.

Graduates of the CPA will receive a framed certificate, a golf shirt and a photograph of the graduating class.

"We are searching for a cross section of people from our community to participate. We have found that the questions and discussion are far more interesting and informative when the class composition is more diverse. CPA is an excellent opportunity to create new partnerships between the police and the community and to create an opportunity for open dialogue with the officers who deliver our services," said Inspector Jackie Gordon.
