**Man charged with stealing mailboxes**

A Milton man is facing 37 charges in connection with stolen mailboxes after Halton Police responded to a single car accident on Sixth Line in Halton Hills Sunday.

There's now a race in Ward 3 for the November 10 municipal election. Stephen Grasby filed his candidacy for one of the two local council seats Monday.

An illegal immigrant, working as a live-in nanny for a Georgetown family, has been charged with assault causing bodily harm after an investigation revealed a 13-month-old boy suffered a leg injury.

Halton Police say the youth will recover. On Sept. 3 Halton Police's Child Abuse and Sexual Assault Bureau received information concerning the boy's injury. Two days later police arrested the nanny, who had been working for the family for six months. Further investigation revealed the woman was in Canada illegally. Immigration officials are now investigating.

Charged is Perianus Sundia Pitt, 24, of no fixed address. She was to appear in Milton court today (Wednesday) for a bail hearing.
