On Sept. 3 Halton Police's Child Abuse and Sexual Assault Bureau received information concerning the boy's injury. Two days later police arrested the nanny, who had been working for the family for six months. Further investigation revealed the woman was in Canada illegally. Immigration officials are now investigating.

Charged is Perianus Sundia Pitt, 24, of no fixed address. She was to appear in Milton court today (Wednesday) for a bail hearing.
