Vehicle stolen in Georgetown

Two teenagers facing variety of charges

wo teens were arrested in Mississauga inside a pickup truck stolen from a Georgetown parking lot recently.

Officers with Peel's Street Crime Unit and 12 Division detectives surrounded the Ford F150 truck as it sat in the parking lot of a plaza on the northeast corner of Tomken Road and Rathburn Road Friday night (Sept. 5). It was 9:15 p.m. and a check of the truck's licence plate revealed it had been stolen from the underground parking garage at 62 Park Ave. the night before, according to police.

Inside the truck police found vice grips, screwdrivers and other tools they said can be used to break into buildings.

Thomas Nicholson, 18, and Andrew Lamore, 18, both of no fixed address, have been charged with possession of stolen property, possession of break and enter tools and breach of probation.

Lamore, who was to report to a local jail that night, has also been charged with breach of recognizance and being unlawfully at large, according to Peel police.

The three new constables who have been assigned to 1 District in Georgetown are Tara Vivian, David McInnis and Moreen Smith.

Vivian is a native of Espanola who joined the Canadian Armed Forces after high school and earned several awards during four years of service. She joined the Greater Sudbury Police Service in 1998 where she worked primarily in uniform and six months in the street crime division. She is also a coach officer. Vivian volunteers with the Special Olympics and is a youth mentor.

McInnis was born in Toronto and continued his post-secondary education at Seneca College, receiving a diploma in 1985 in law enforcement. He worked as a correctional officer for 17 years and was on the Ministry Tactical Response Team for 11 years. He was a use of force instructor and resigned at the rank of Lieutenant Operation Manager to join Halton Police.

In 1999 he received a Ministers Award for Exceptional Bravery and is also the recipient of several Ontario correctional fitness awards. He is married with children.

Smith, a Toronto native, joined the Toronto Police Service in 1989 and worked at 54 Division for nine years in various offices, including area foot patrol and the criminal investigation bureau. In 1998 she transferred to the mounted unit, performing her duties on horseback. She has a son and lives with her family in Halton.
