## Bach Chorale joins with quintet for first concert of its season

The Georgetown Bach Chorale starts off its sea-A son with A Change of Season — Autumn Concert at the Halton Hills Cultural Centre Gallery, 9 Church St., on Saturday, Oct. 25 at 8 p.m.

The Chorale will be singing with a chamber quintet consisting of both harpsichord and piano in turn with violin, viola, cello and double bass.

The Chorale's artistic director Ron Greidanus will be performing on the harpsichord and on his own nine-foot grand piano, which has been moved into the Gallery for this concert.

instrumental movements enhanced by the choral responses.

Also, the audience will be treated to Schubert's Piano Quintet in A major, the famous The Trout, a set of variations for piano and strings based on Schubert's own delightful song Die Forelle.


Greidanus will follow by playing an etude, No. 12 in C minor and a nocturne, No. 1 in F major by Chopin.


